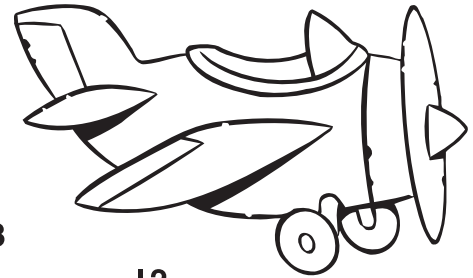
Fire Insurance

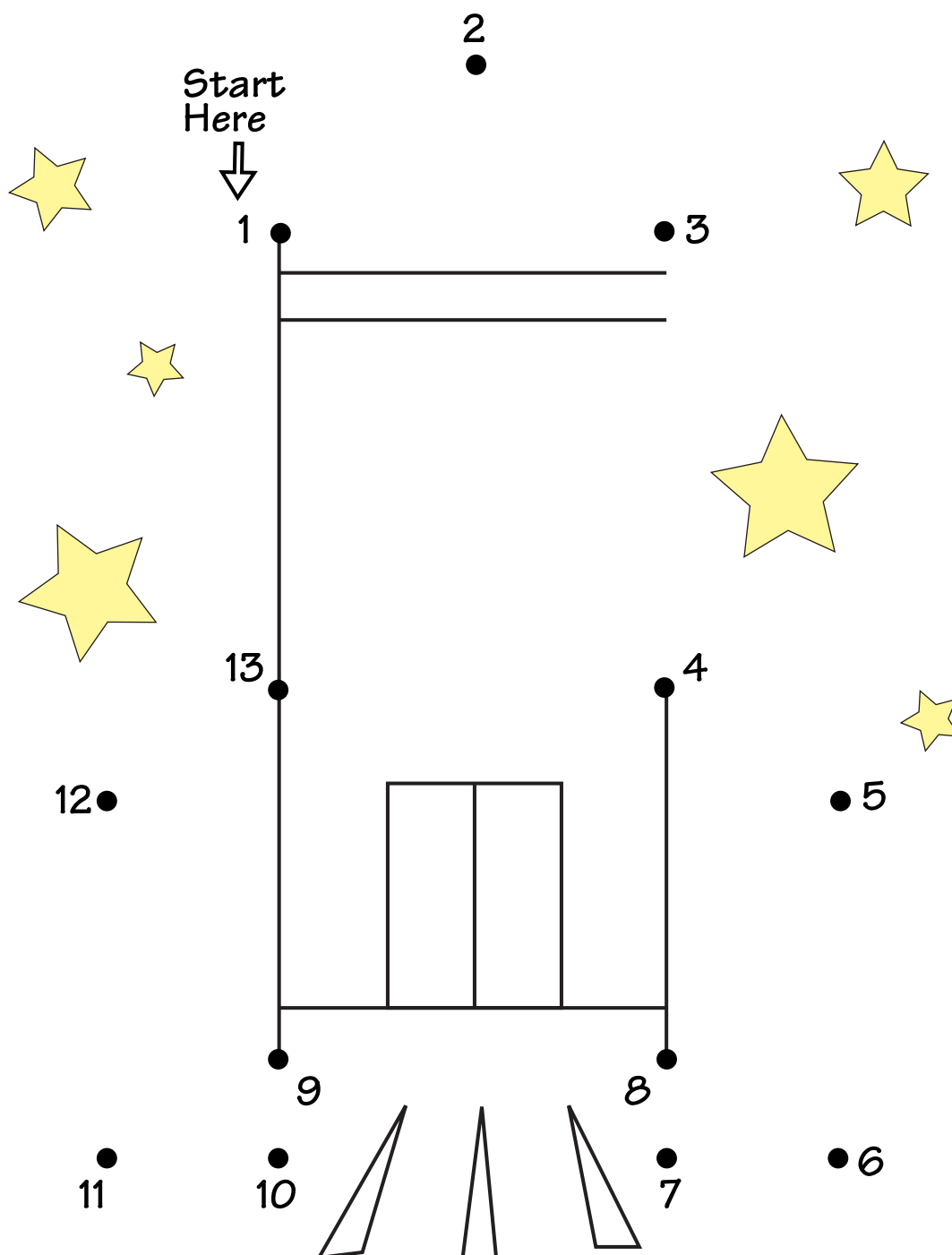


A Nice Umbrella



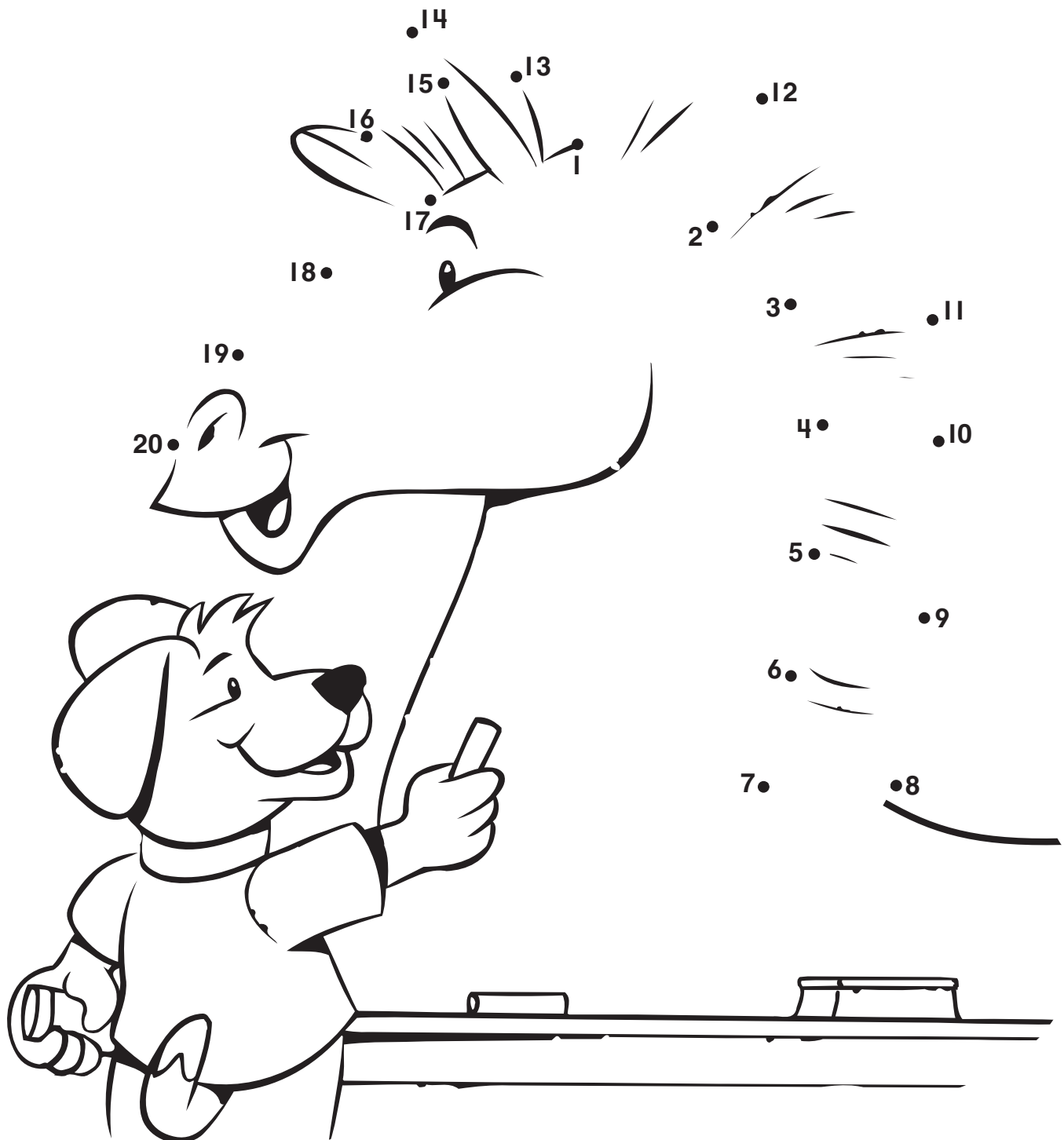
The cap of a mushroom makes tiny spores, which fall to the ground and grow into new mushrooms.

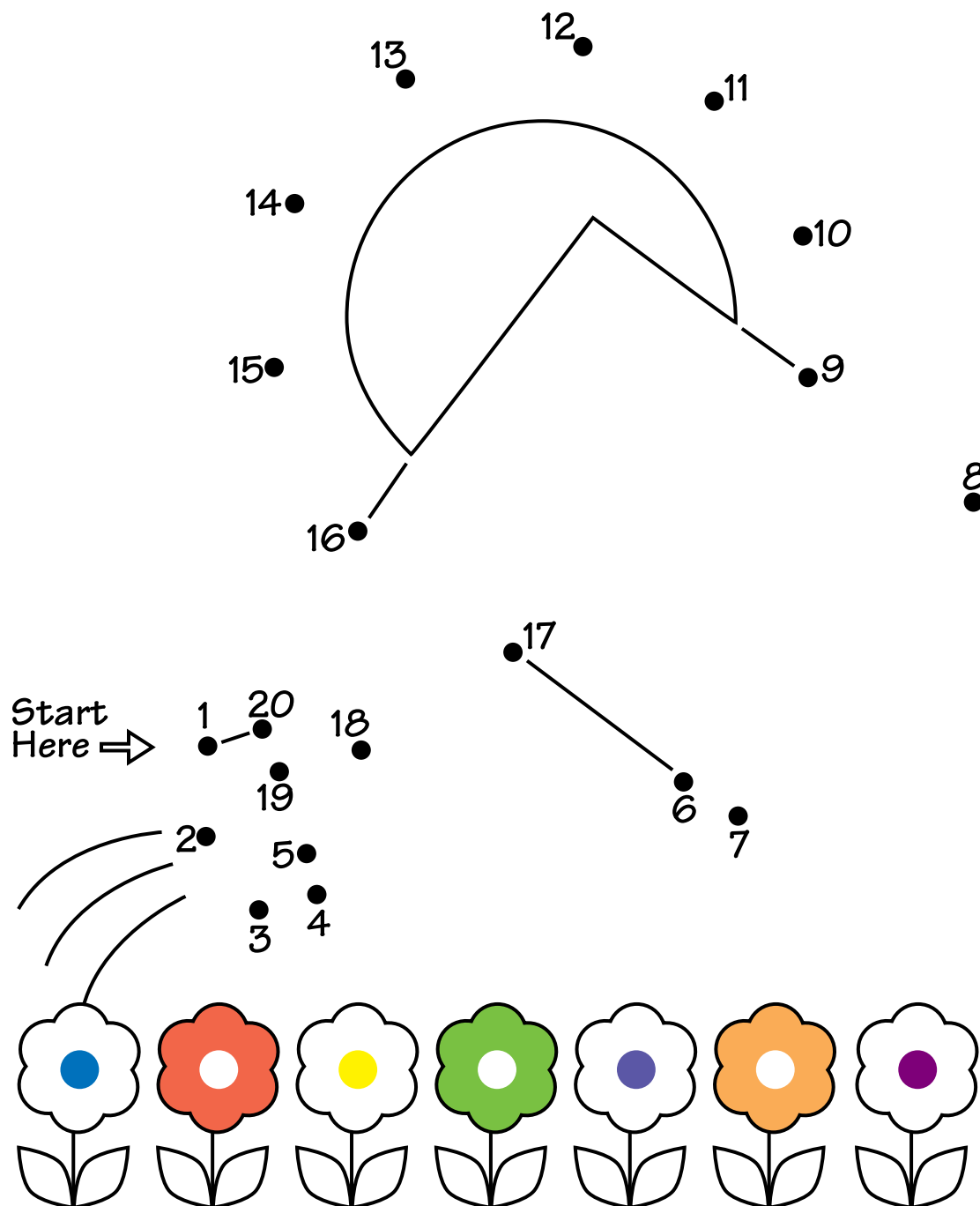
Whistling in the Water



Dolphins "talk" to each other with whistling and clicking sounds.

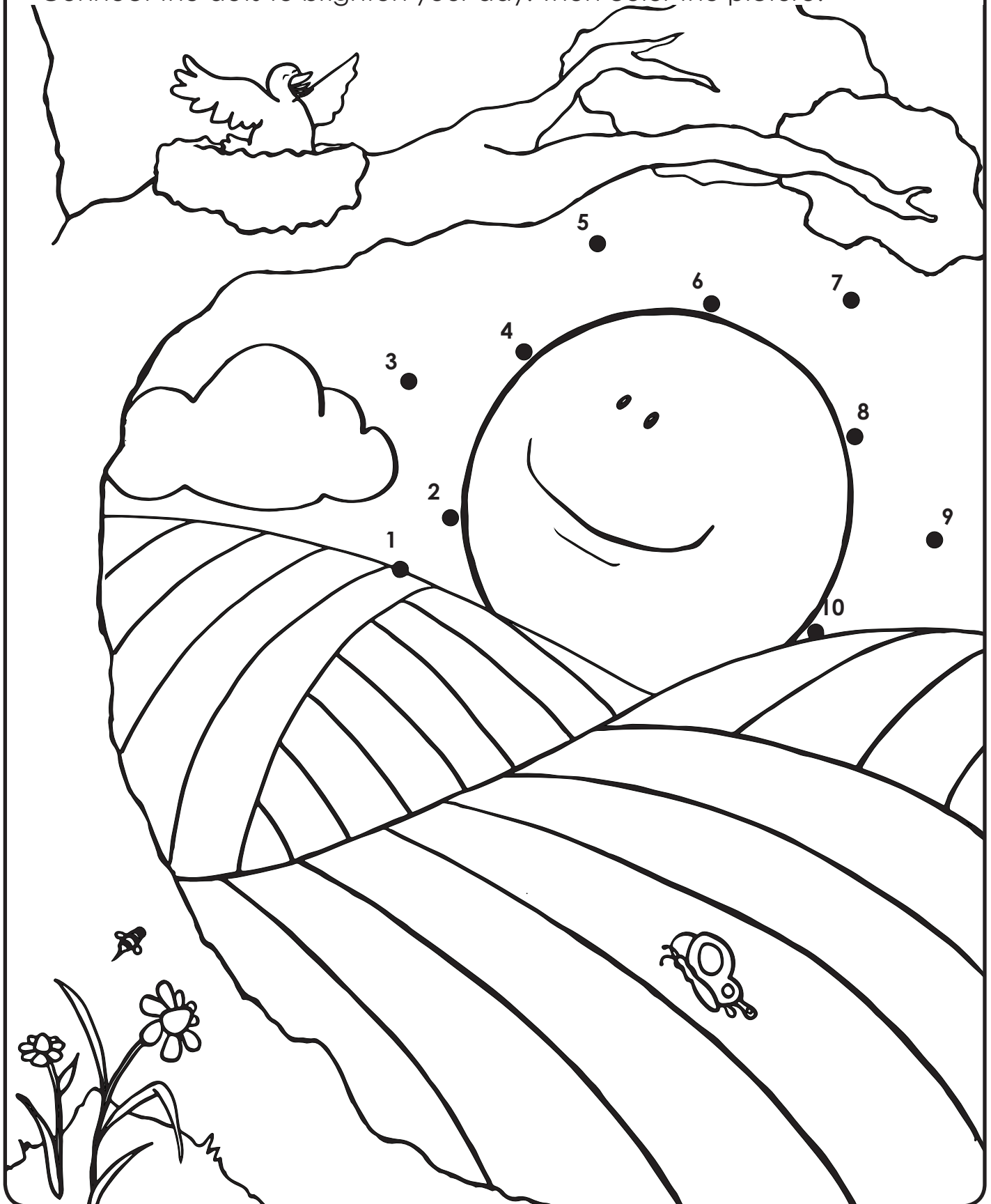

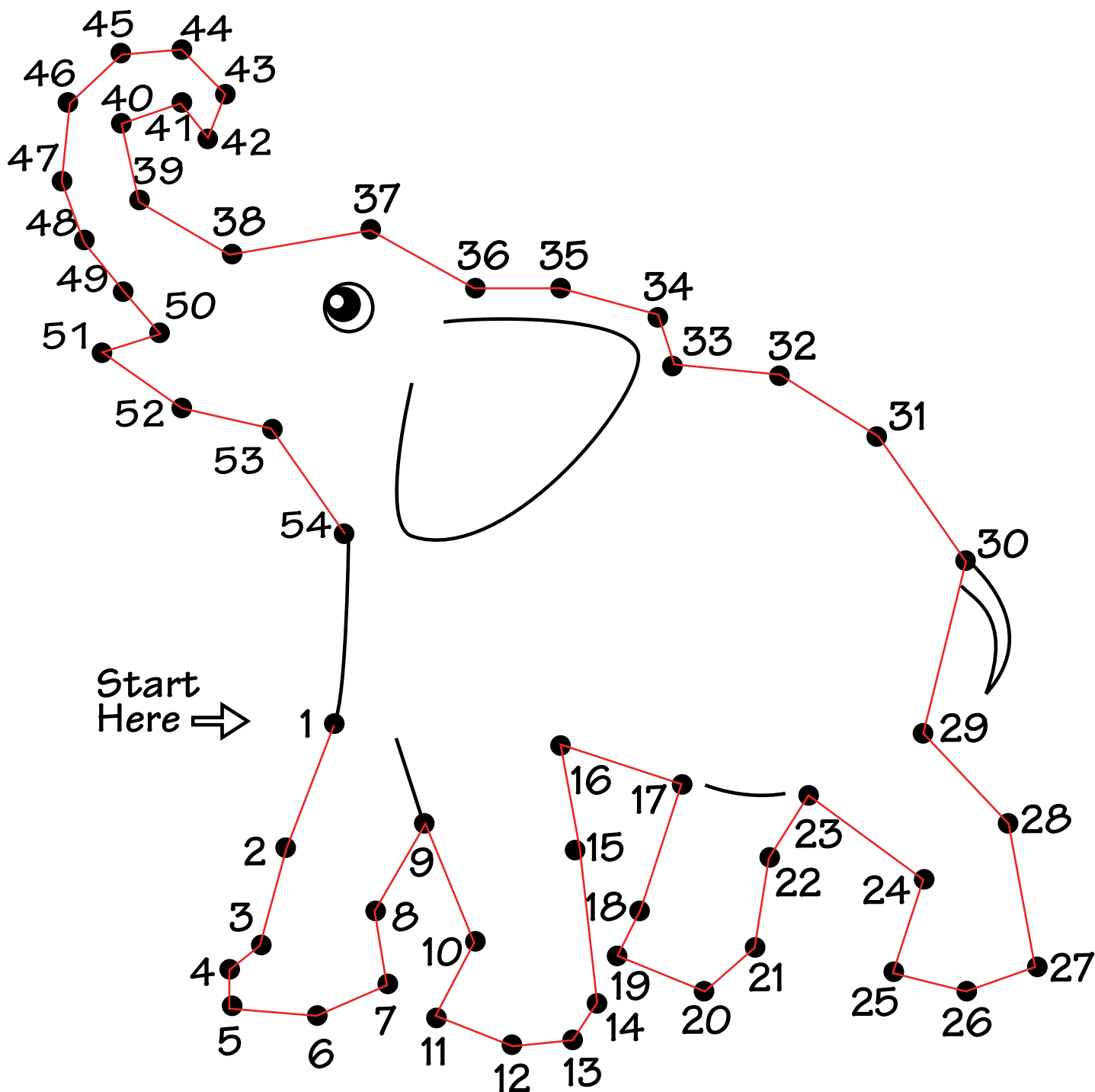

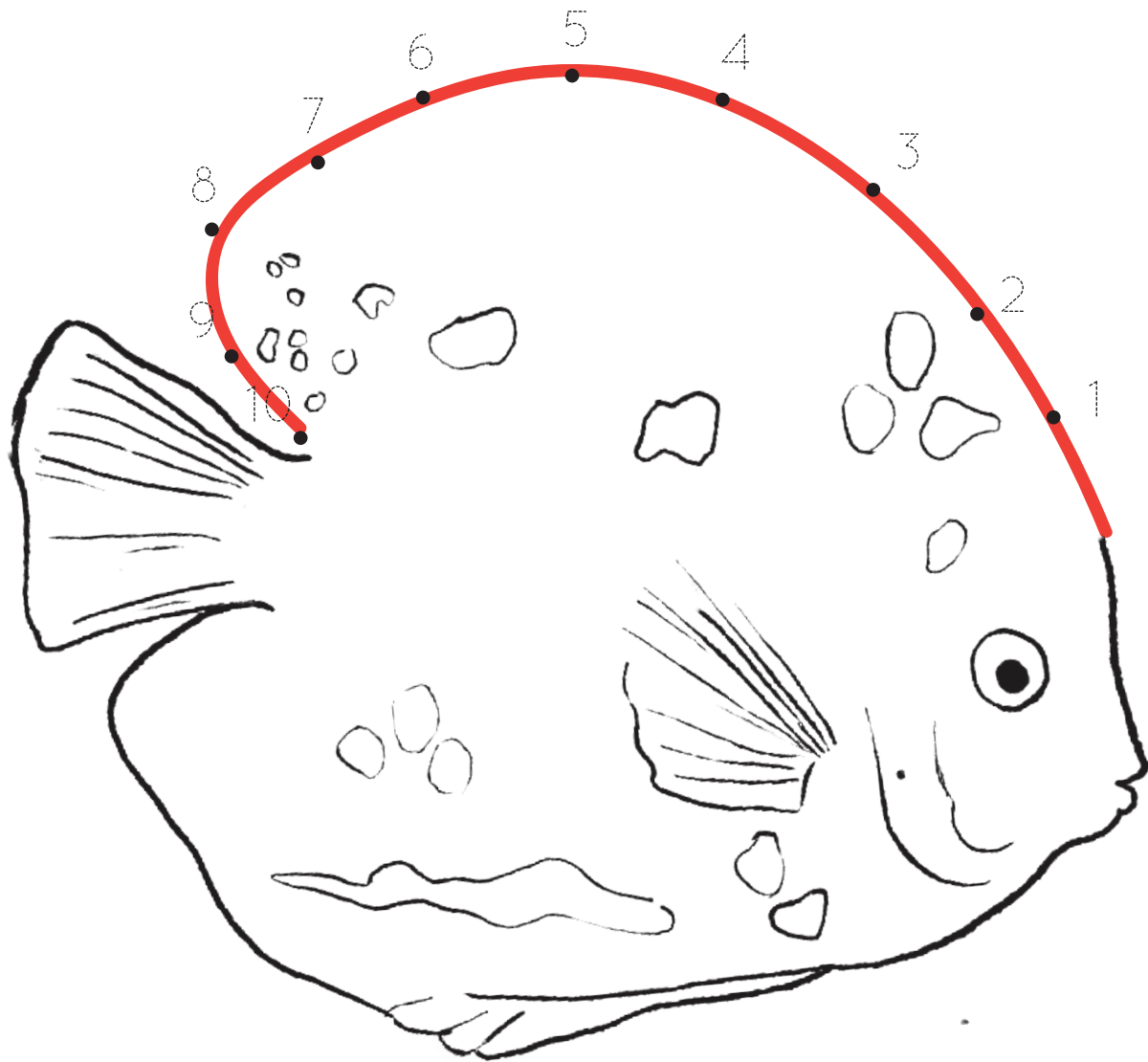
