

Fire fighters wear hard hats on the job to protect themselves from falling objects.








A Nice Umbrella



The cap of a mushroom makes tiny spores, which fall to the ground and grow into new mushrooms.










Dot to Dot 1-10 What's Hiding?




Whistling in the Water




Dolphins "talk" to each other with whistling and clicking sounds.






