Printable Hector

Print out and assemble a posable Hector skeleton to decorate a door or window!

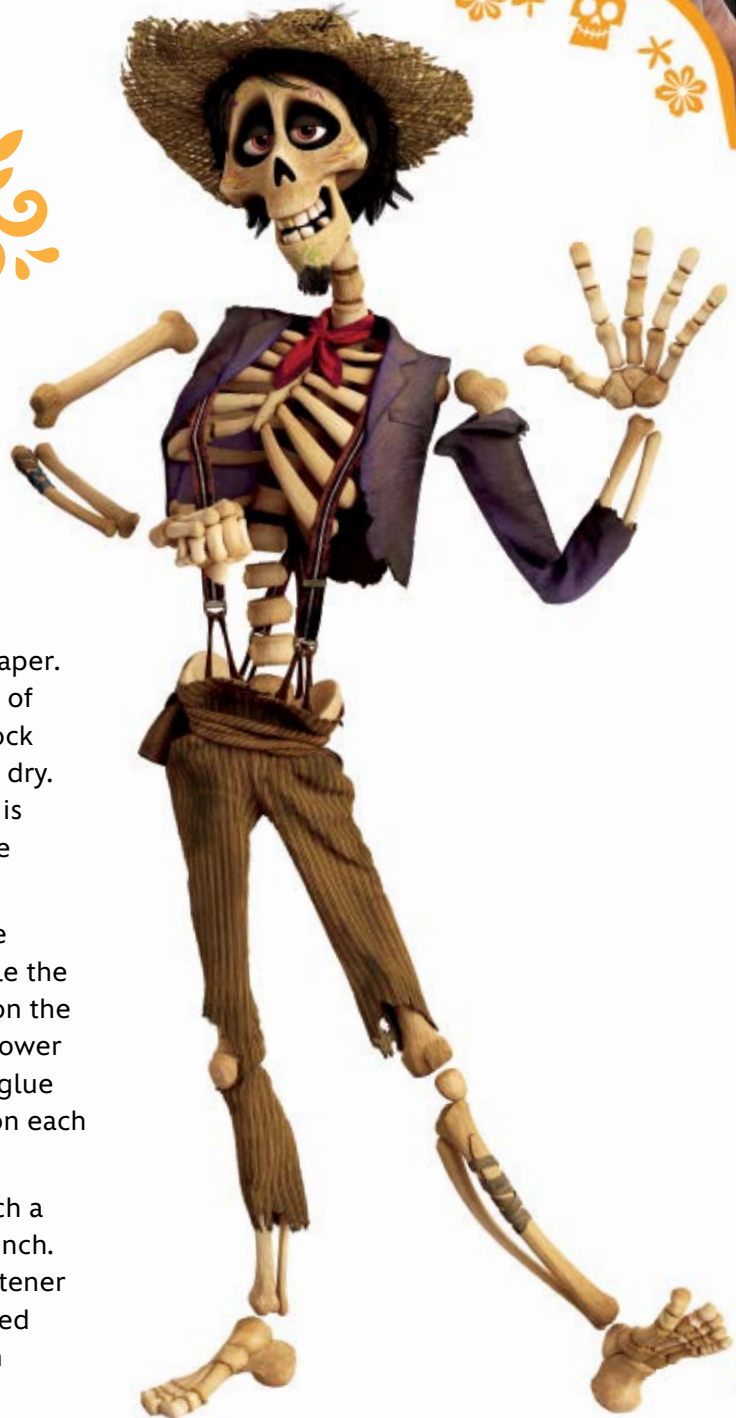


What you will need:

- 18 Regular white paper and heavy card stock paper
- 18 Glue stick
- 18 Hole punch
- 18 Round head metal fasteners
- 18 Scissors
Kids, have a grown up help you with the scissors.

Instructions:

1. Print out pages 2 - 6 on regular white paper. Generously apply glue stick to the back of each page and adhere to heavy card stock paper. Press the paper together and let dry. To keep the paper from curling while it is drying, place a heavy book on top of the glued paper.
2. Once the glue has dried, cut around the artwork and connector tabs. To assemble the body, apply glue to the area indicated on the skeleton's upper body and line up the lower body to glue them together. Allow the glue to dry. **Tip:** Match up the colored dots on each piece before moving on to step 3.
3. Locate two dots of the same color. Punch a hole through each dot with the hole punch. Align the holes and insert the metal fastener to secure. Move to the next set of colored dots and repeat until all of the skeleton pieces are connected.
