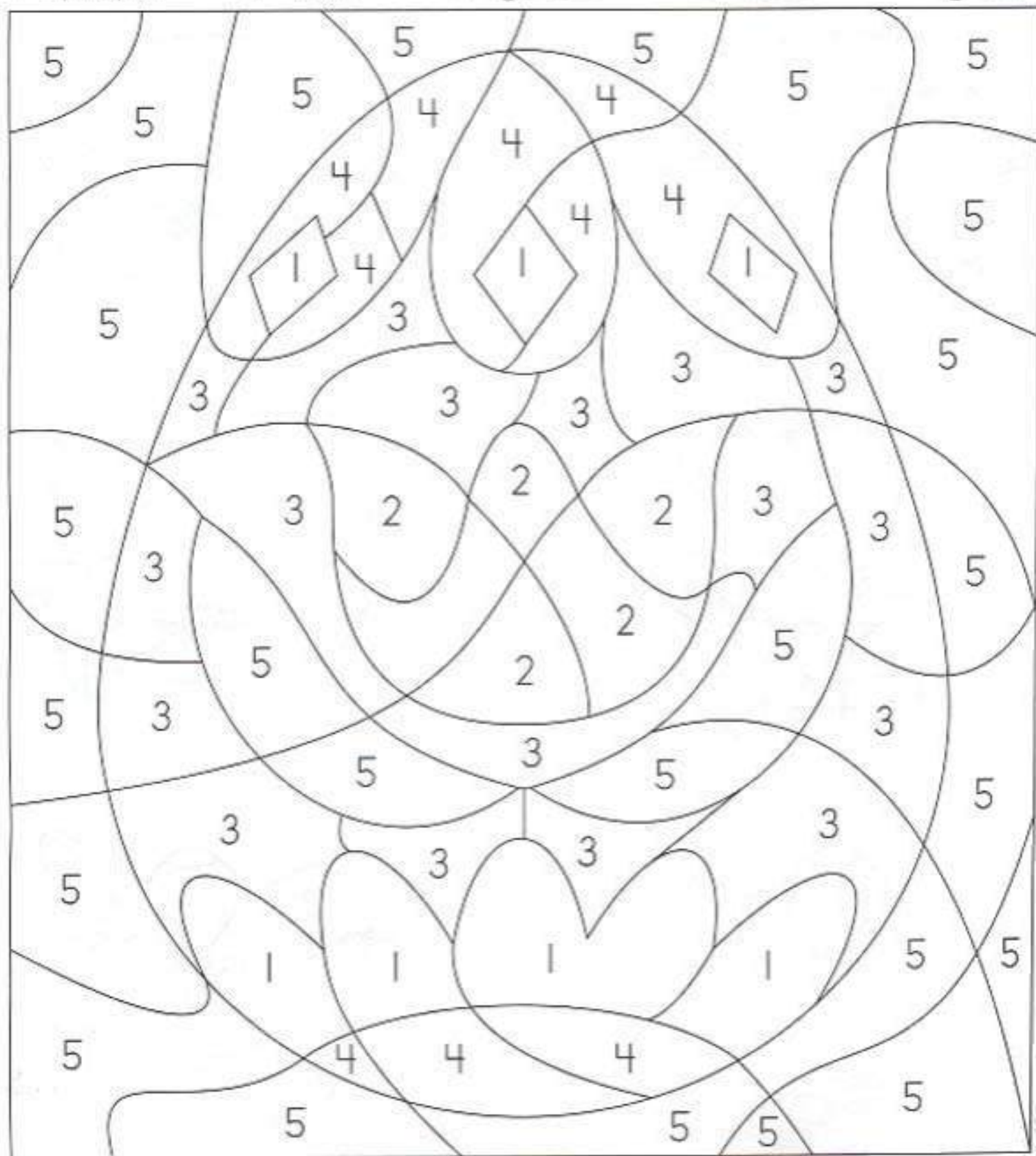

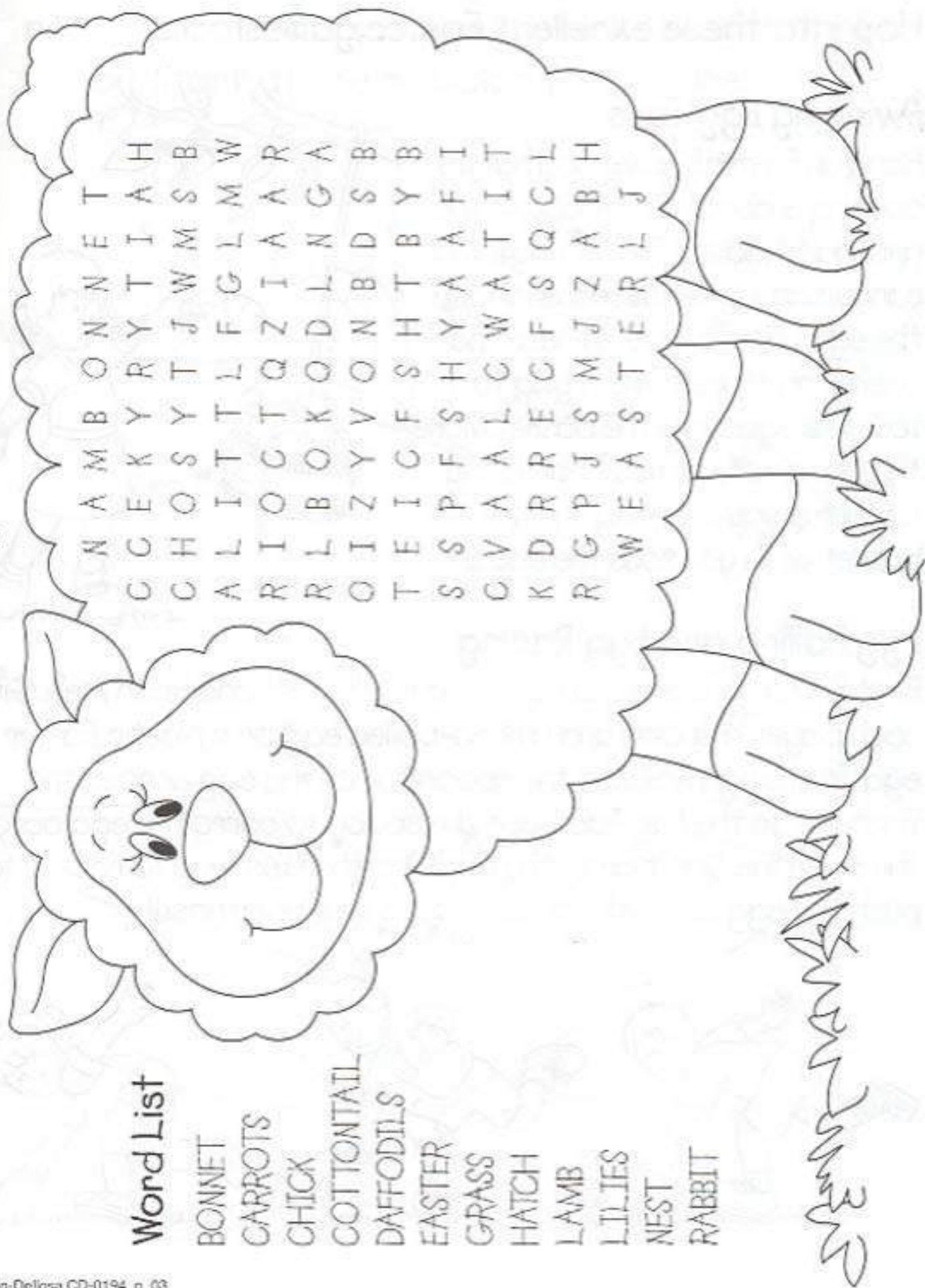

Swinging Egg Toss

Hang an Easter basket so that its opening is about 2 feet above the ground. Fill plastic Easter eggs with candy, sand, or birdseed, and tape the eggs closed. Line up near the basket and take turns trying to toss the eggs into the basket. Make the game more difficult by moving farther away or swinging the basket while you toss the eggs.

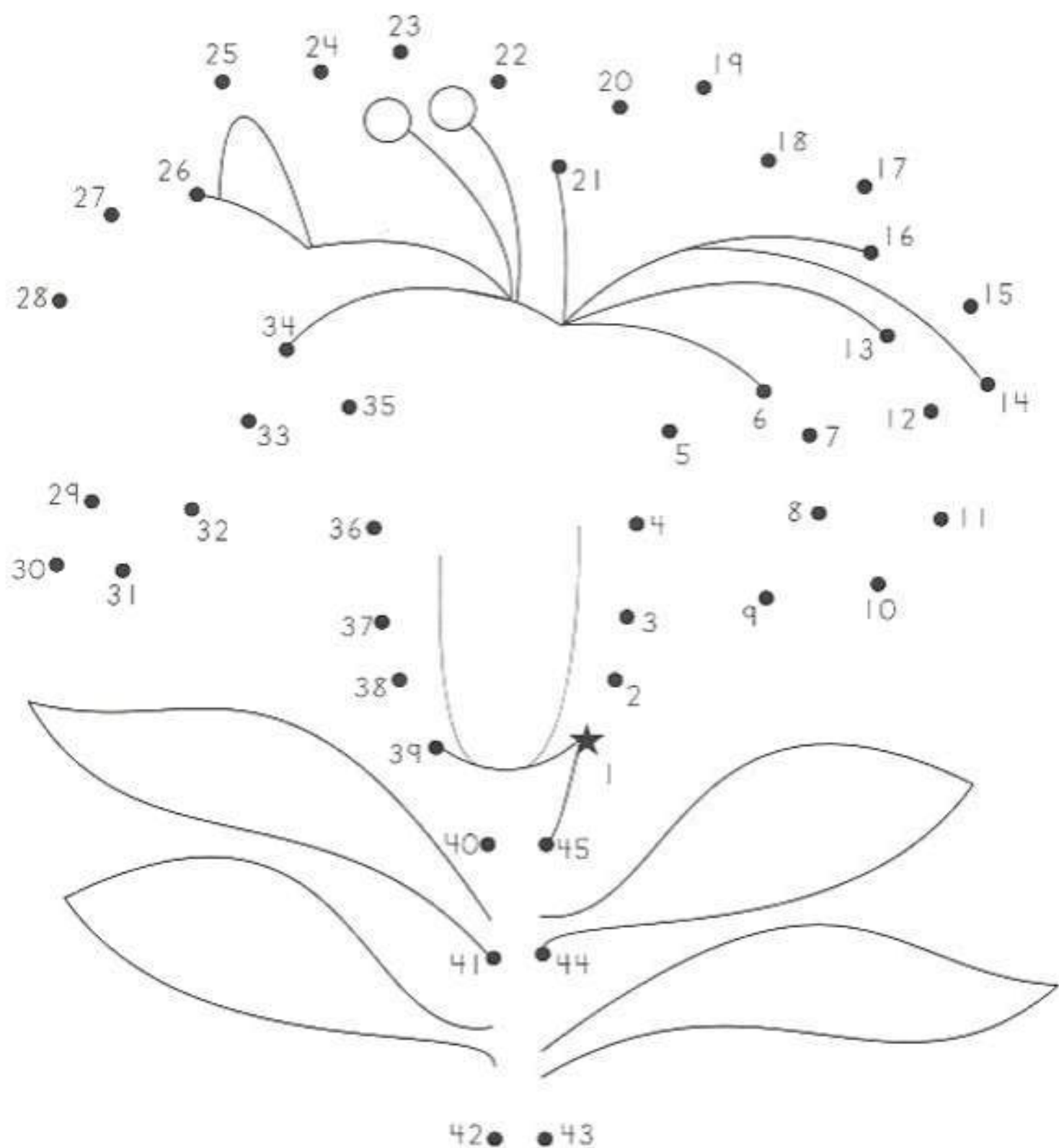


Egg Rolling and Egg Racing

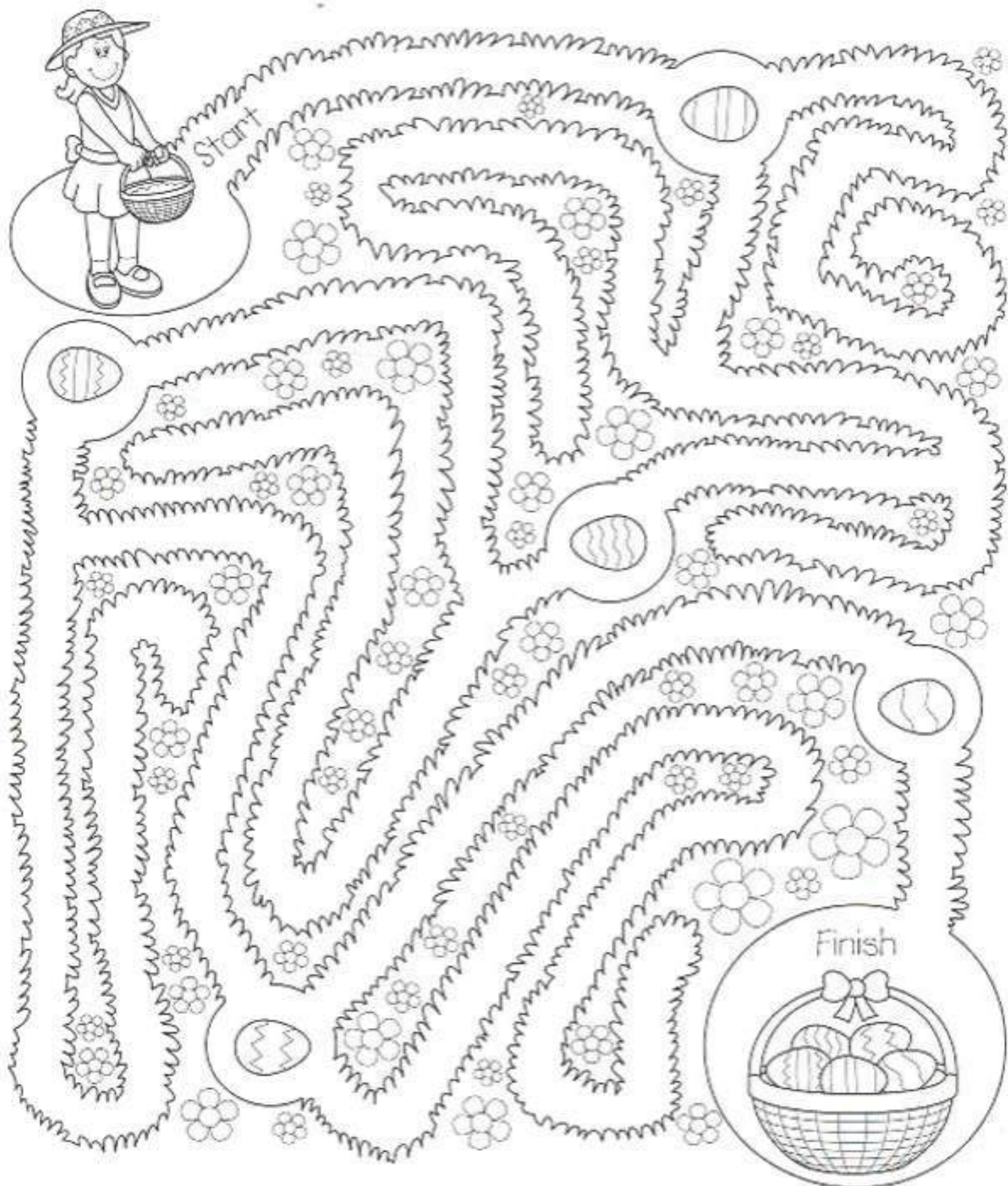
First, find a safe area to race, and mark start and finish lines. Give each player a spoon and a hard-boiled egg or a plastic Easter egg. In the Egg Roll, use the spoon to roll the egg across the finish line. In the Egg Race, use the spoon to carry the egg across the finish line. Don't drop the egg! Another fun way to race is to push the egg along the ground using only your nose!

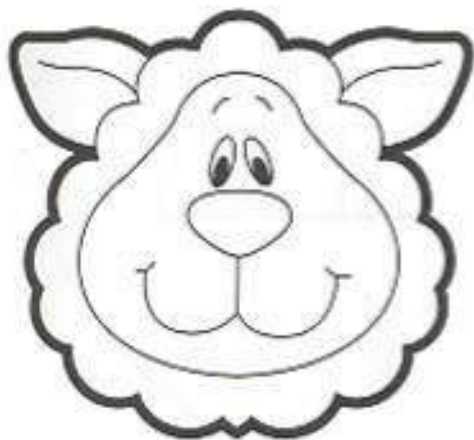

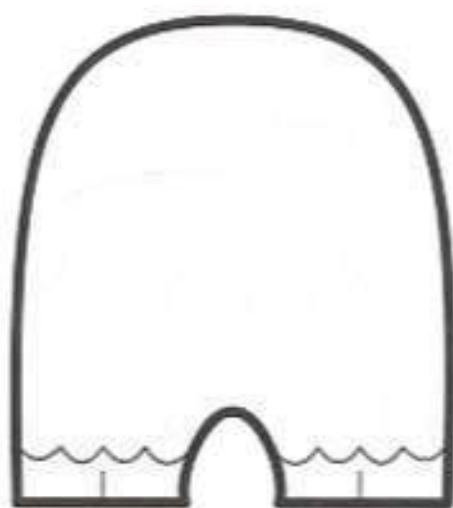

3. Glue cotton balls around the outside of each tube and add a cotton-ball tail.



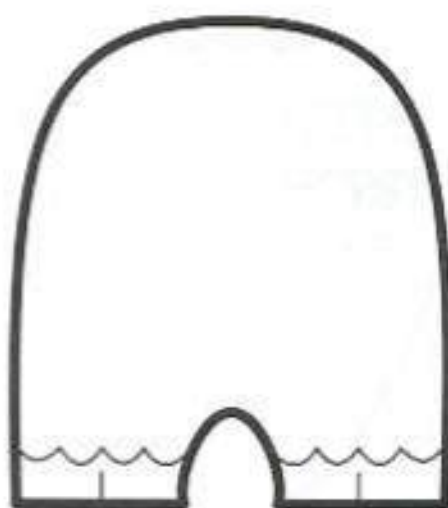

Jelly Bean Carrots

First, cut a 1 foot square of orange cellophane. Cut the square into 2 triangles. Roll each triangle into a cone shape. Secure each cone with tape. Fill the cones with jelly beans. Place green raffia in the open end of each cone, then twist the ends closed. Secure the end of each "carrot" with a green raffia bow.



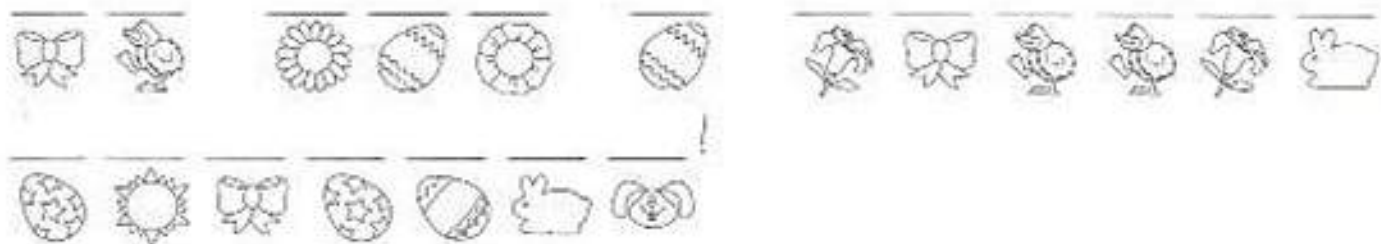
"Hand"-made Easter Lilies

Try making this unique Easter bouquet! Trace your hand several times on white paper. Cut out the hand shapes and roll each into a cone with the palm at the base and the fingers open. Tape the edges of the palm together, making sure to leave a small hole at the base of the palm. Use your fingers or scissors to curl the finger "petals" outward. To make a stem, curl the end of a green chenille craft stick to create a small circle. Thread the craft stick through the hole from the top. Wedge the circle into the bottom of the cone. Fill a vase with these lilies to spread Easter cheer.

Rubber Band Eggs

Wrap a hard-boiled egg with rubber bands. Dip the egg in dye, allowing the dye to get under some of the rubber bands. When the color is right, remove the egg. Dry it gently with a paper towel. Remove the rubber bands. If desired, repeat with another color.



Squiggle Eggs

With an adult's help, drip strands of rubber cement onto a hard-boiled egg. Allow the rubber cement to dry completely. Dip the egg in dye. When the color is right, remove the egg and let it dry. Gently peel off the rubber cement to see a pattern. For added color, repeat the steps with a different dye.

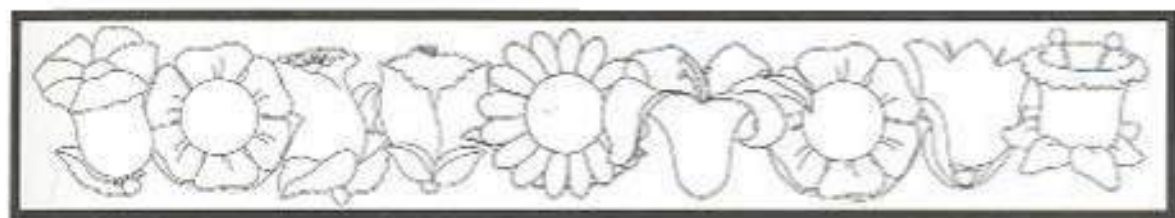
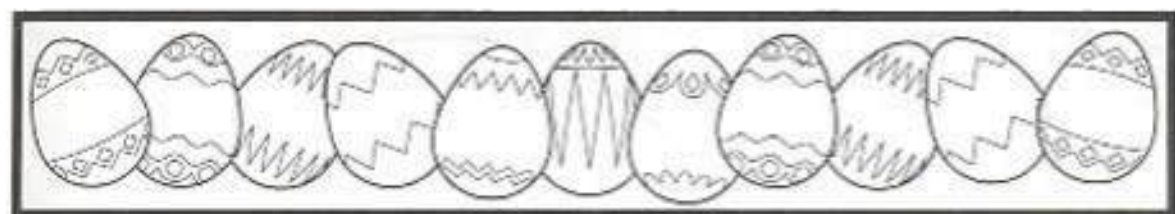


Fingerprint Eggs

Put different colors of tempera paint on a paper plate. Carefully hold the ends of a hard-boiled egg with a finger and thumb. Using a different color each time, dip one fingertip in the paint, dab the extra paint on a paper towel, and cover the egg with your colored fingerprints. Let dry. Now you have a design as unique as you are!

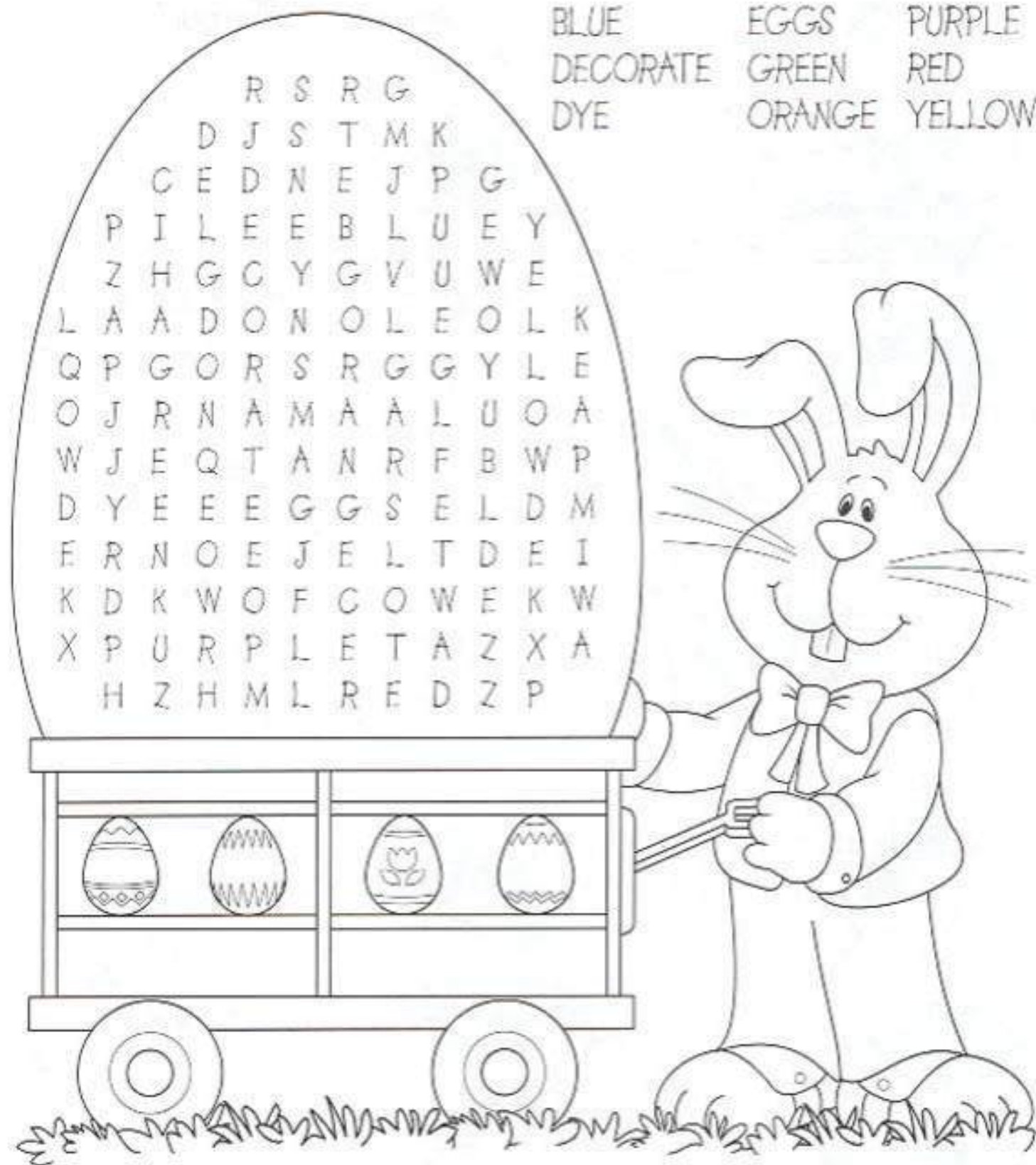

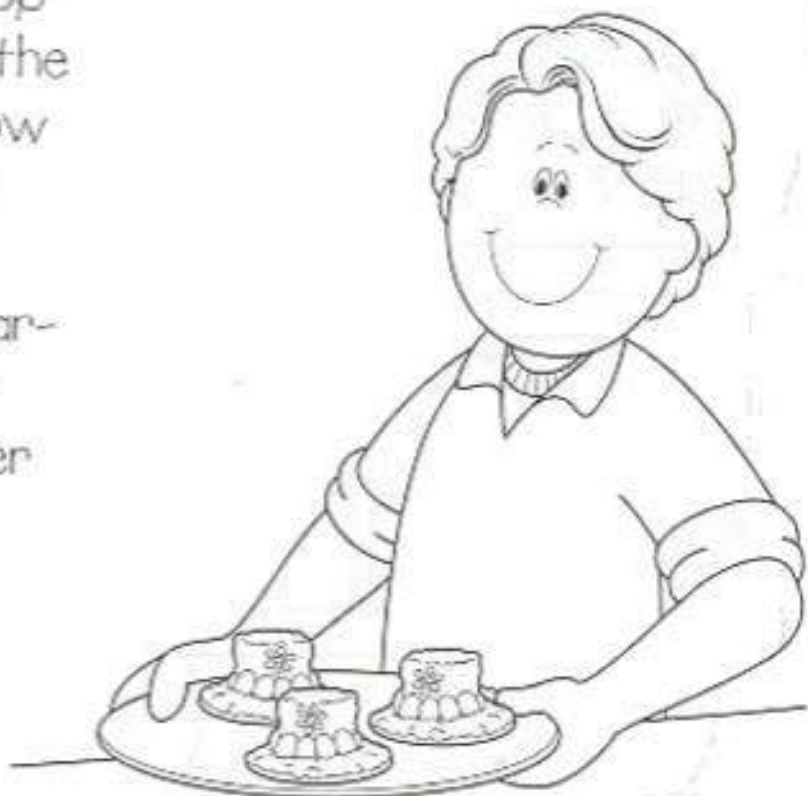


Frozen Easter Baskets

Easter Hats

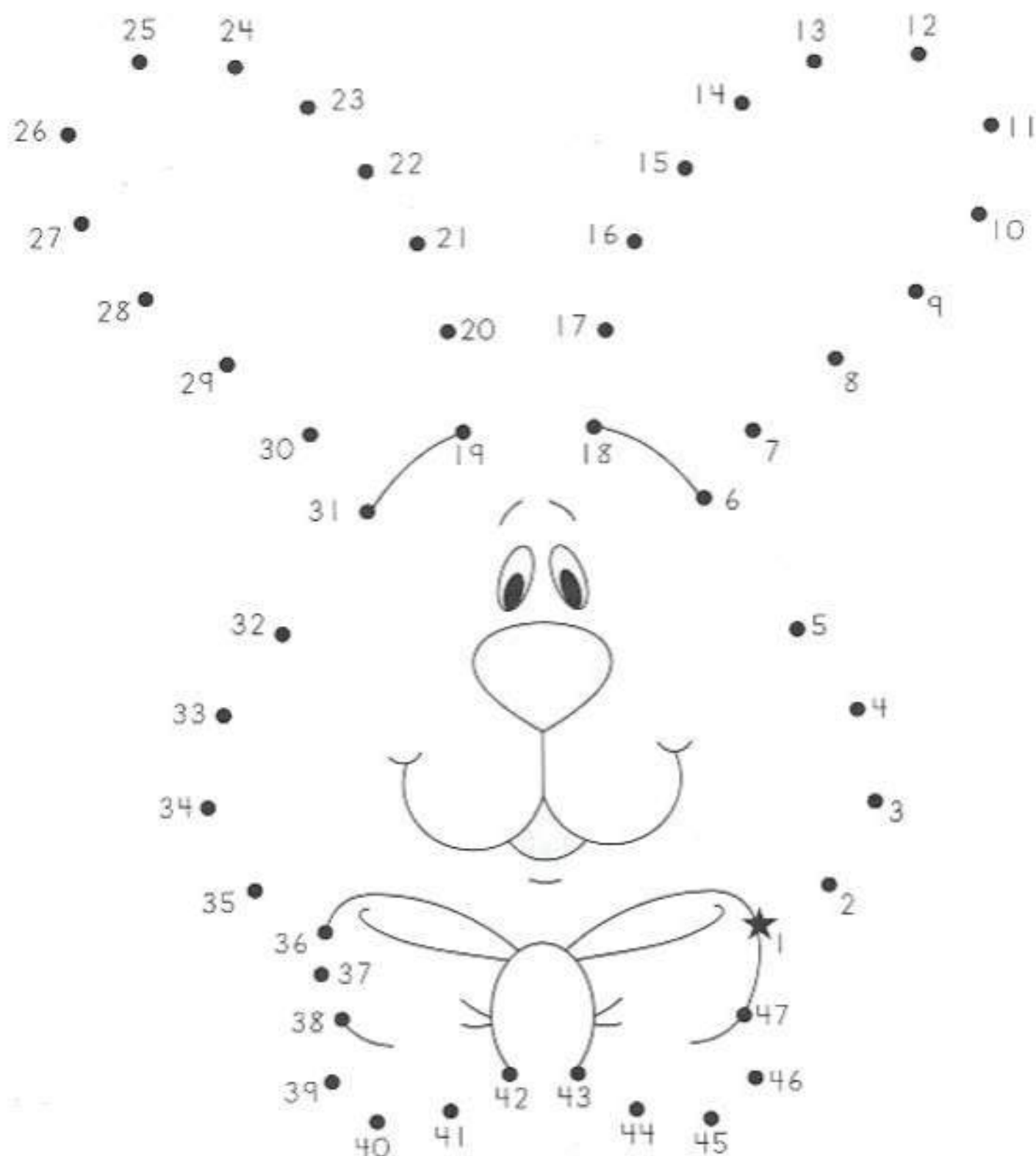

You will need 4–6 clean, dry eggshell halves for this activity.

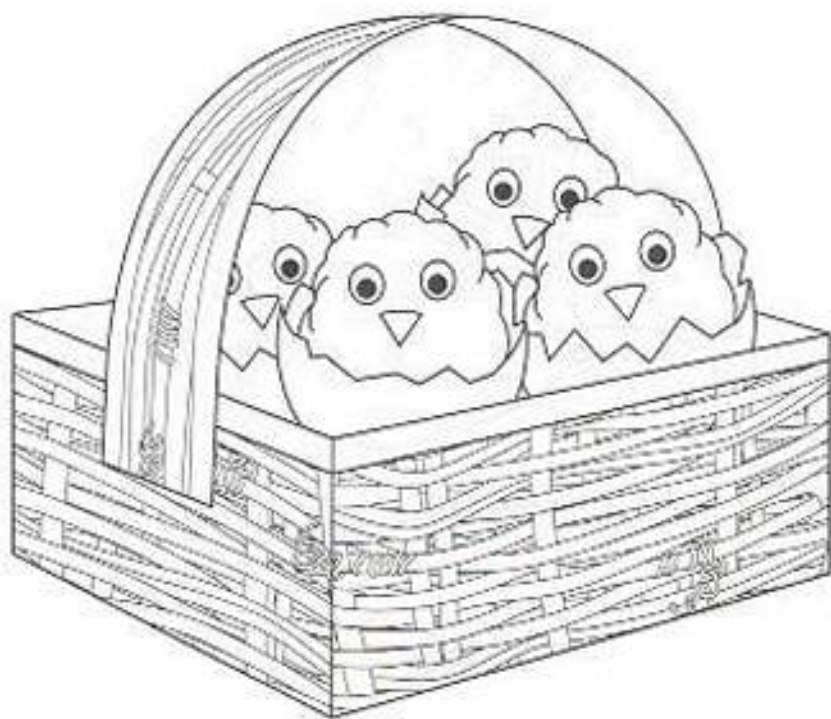
1. Glue a white or yellow cotton ball to the inside of each eggshell half.

3. Make beaks by cutting small triangle or diamond shapes out of orange construction paper.
4. Glue the beaks to the cotton-ball peeps, then let the glue dry.



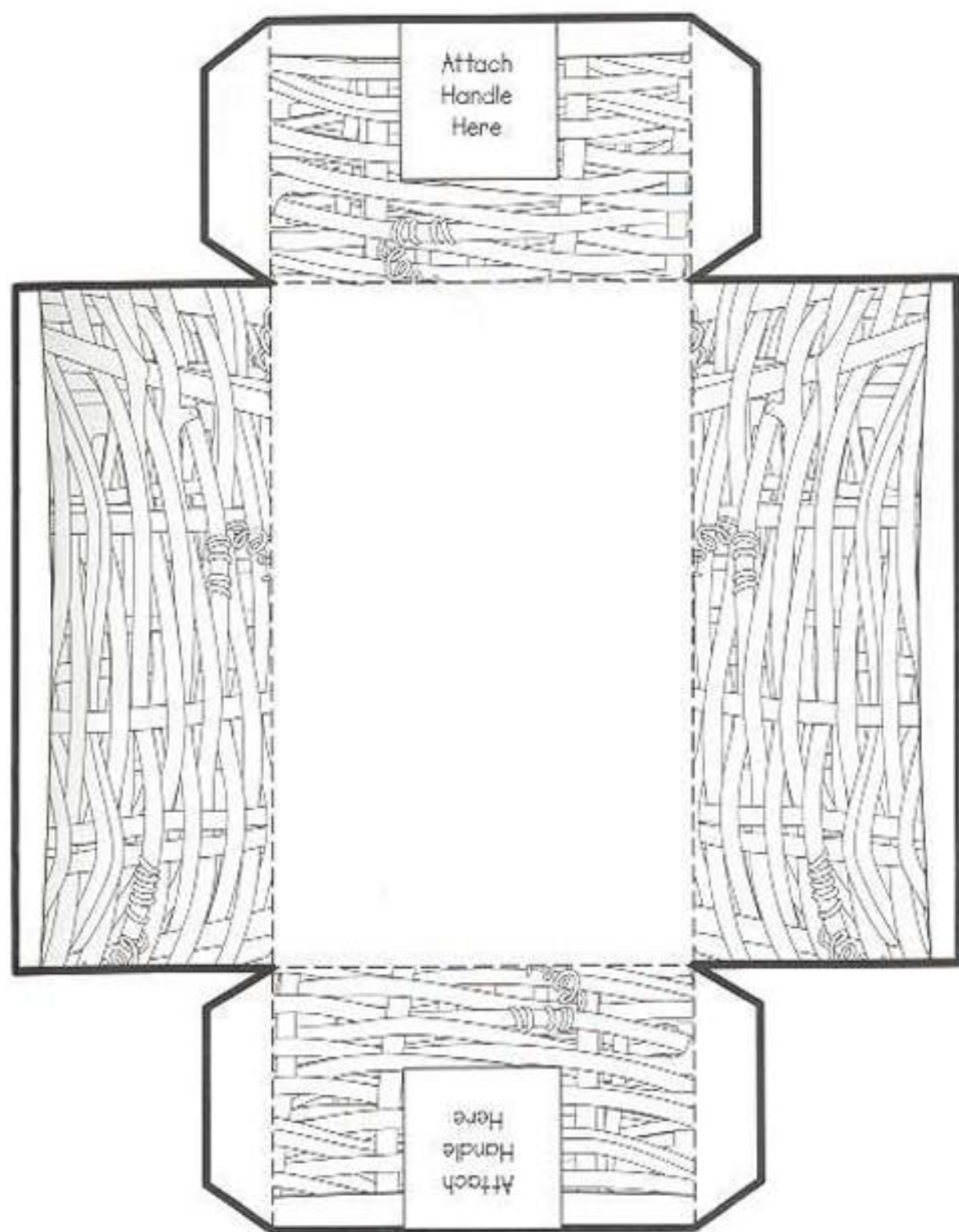
Easter Basket

Use the patterns on page 31 to make an Easter basket for your cotton-ball peeps.

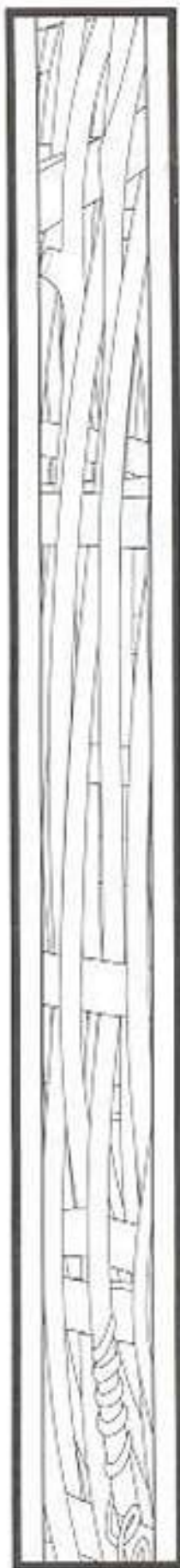
1. Color and cut out the basket and handle patterns.
