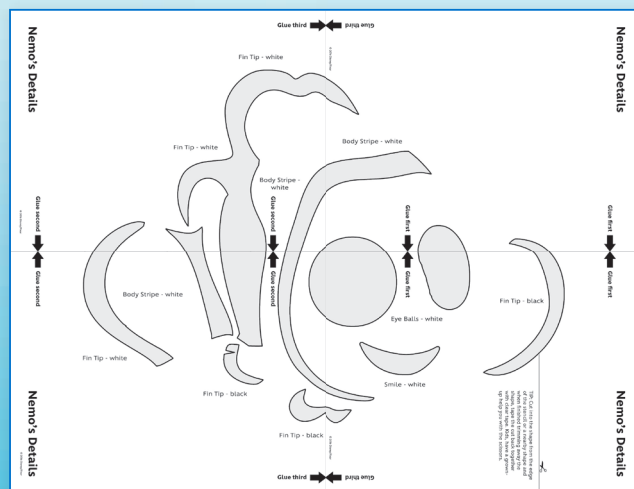
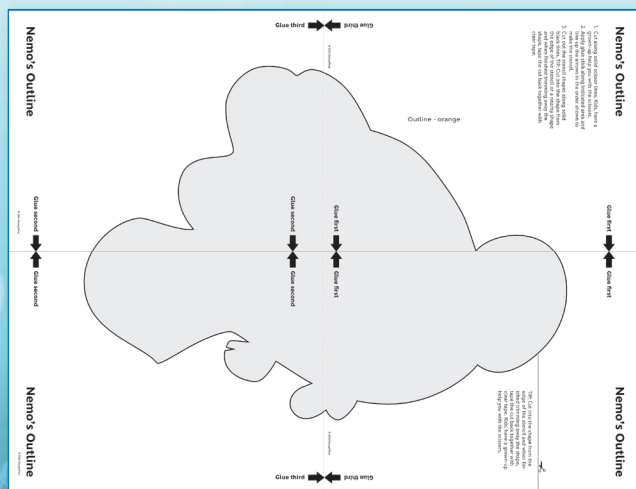


## A drawing of Nemo the clownfish from Disney's Finding Nemo, colored in orange and white, set within a blue oval frame.

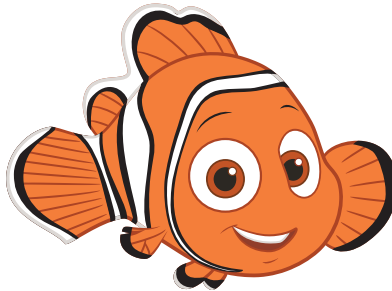

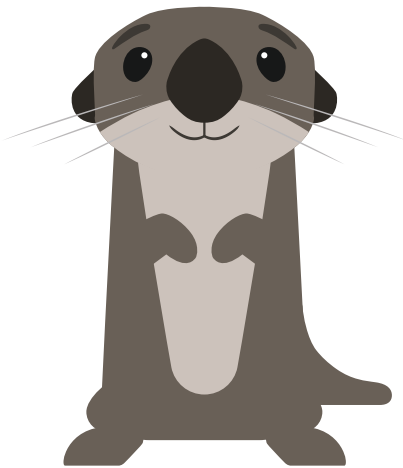

# How To Play Hopscotch

## Set Up Your Design

Draw your hopscotch design. The design can be very basic as shown here or you can make up your own a design with as many boxes as you wish, but have single and double squares and keep them in a straight line. Number the boxes in numerical order.

## How To Play

Each player will need a marker, which can be a bottle cap, stone or a bean bag. The marker must land in the correct box when you toss it, otherwise you lose your turn. To play, hop on just one foot per box. Be sure not to touch a line or go out of sequence. If you miss, the next player goes.

Toss your marker to land in the correct box from low to high, and then skip over that box, hopping all the way to the end and back. Pick up the marker on the way back while avoiding the box. When the highest number is reached, then the game switches to high to low numbers until a player reaches the first box and wins the game!
