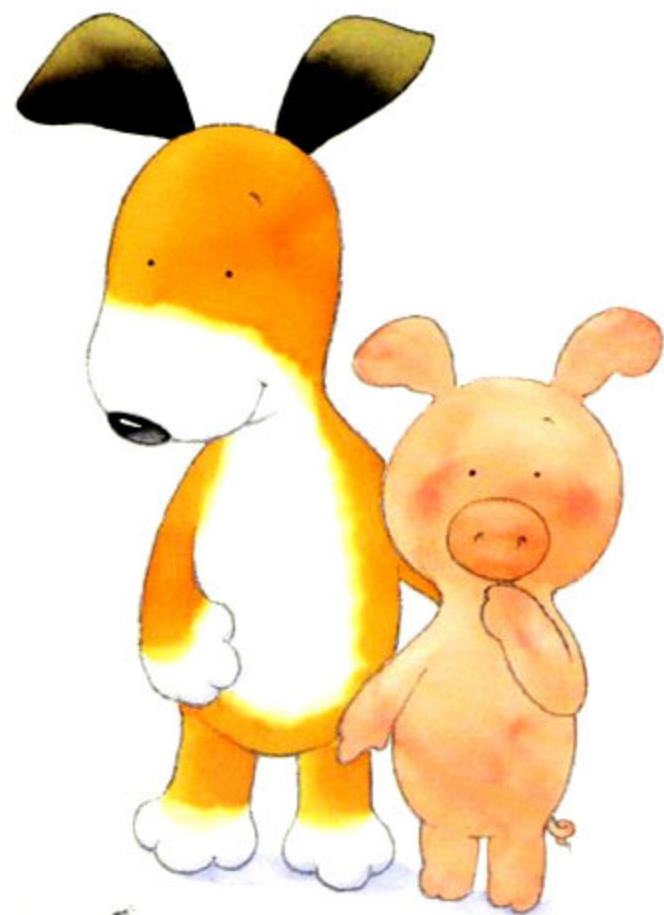


This is Kipper's little

A ^{ant}a is for ant.

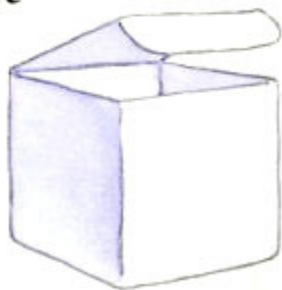
And AArnold.

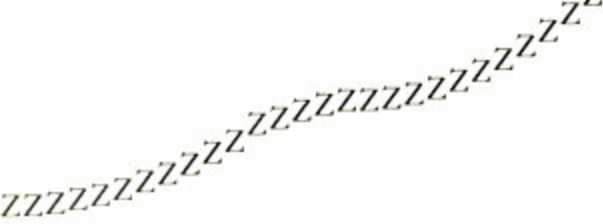


Bb is for box

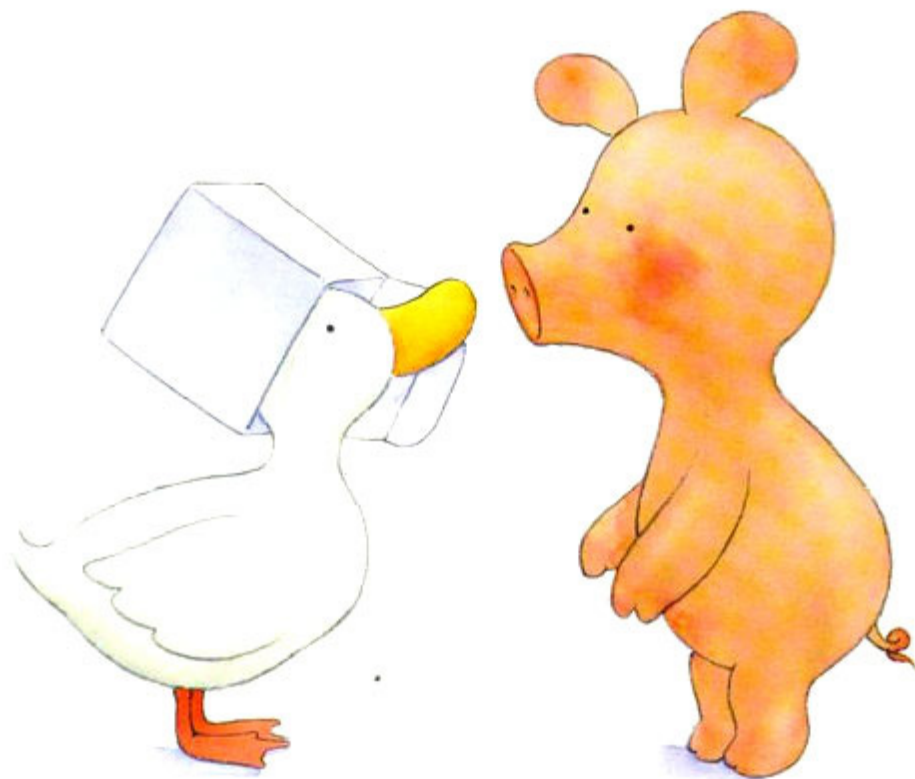
They put the ant

the bumblebee.



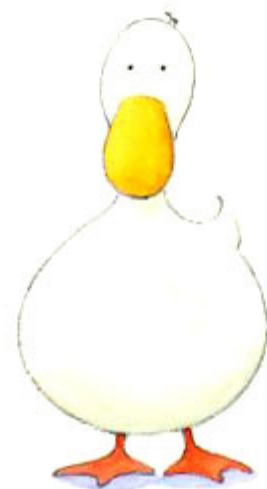


“Let’s find something beginning with C,” said Kipper.

enormous elephant!

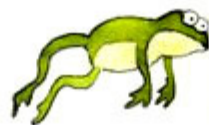
Ee

It was too **f**ast!



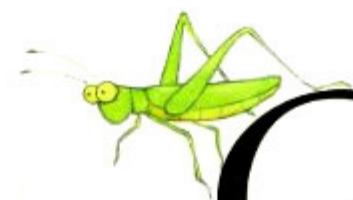
Ff is for frog.

and happy.

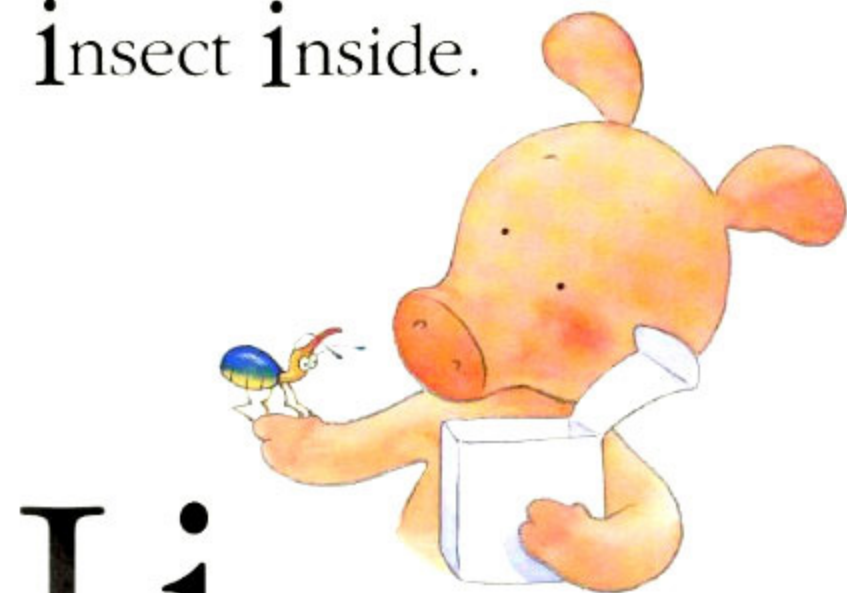
They skipped all the way to the top

beginning with K.

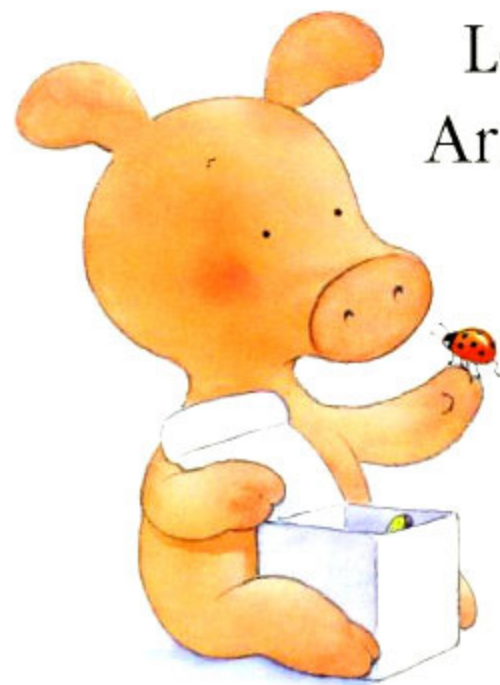

Kk is for...

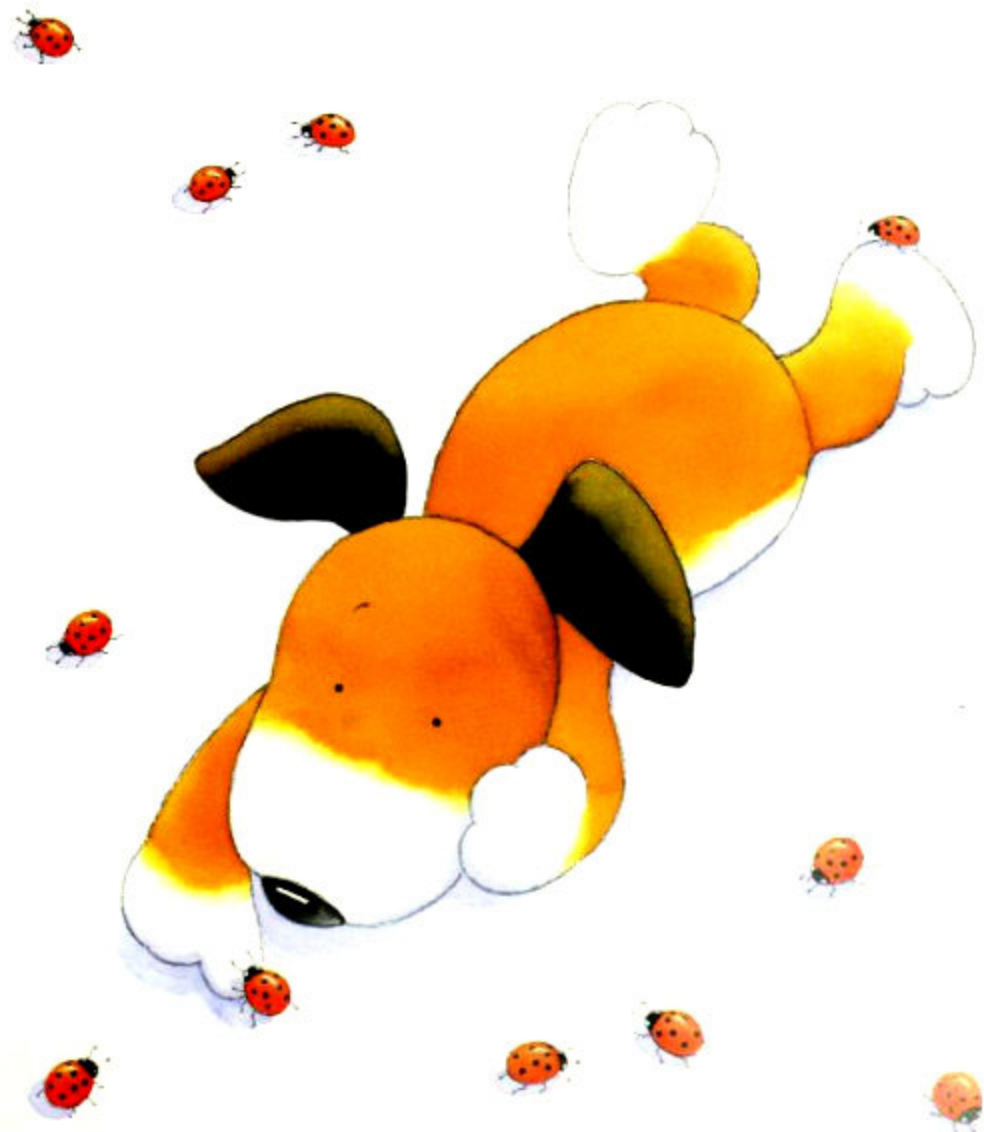


L was easy.

in his box.

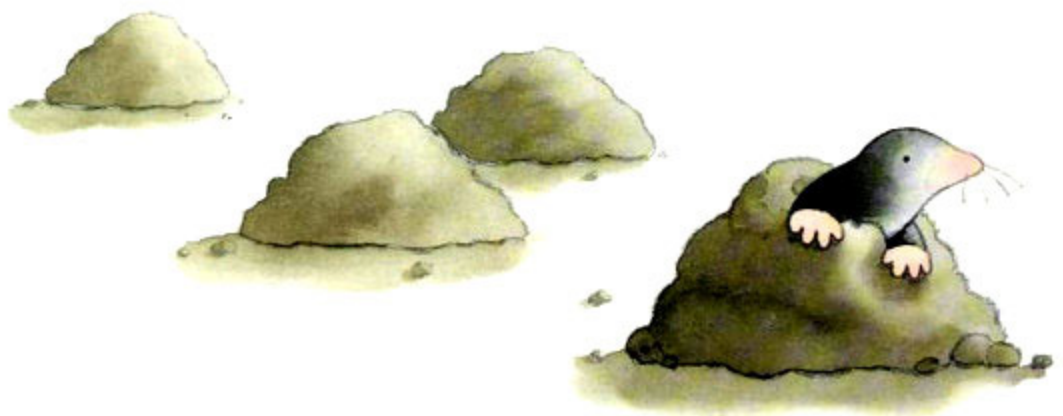


Ll is for

No, not now!

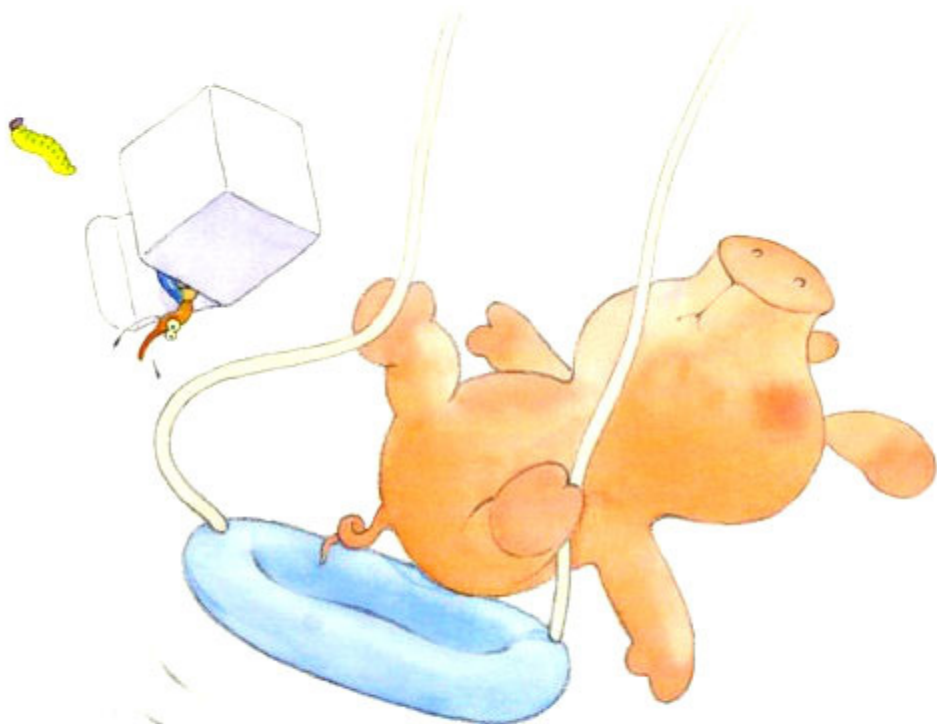


Arnold climbed **O**n the swing.

And then he fell **O**ff again.

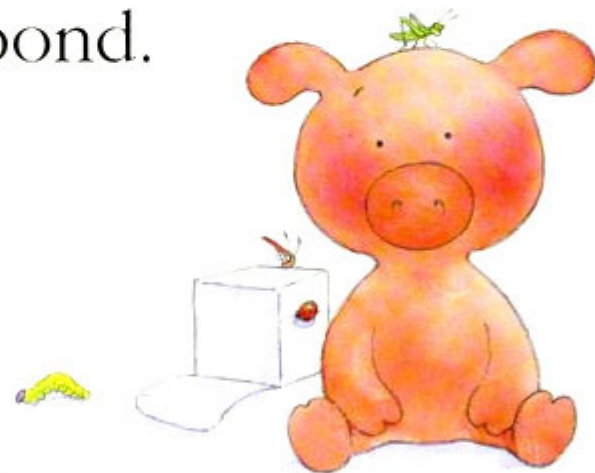


and **off**. And **oo** is for **oops**!

down outside.

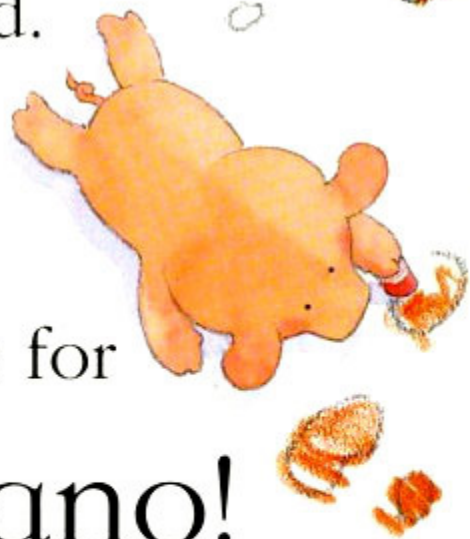
U u is for

they could see for W.

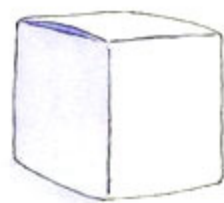


W w is for

Xugglybug!

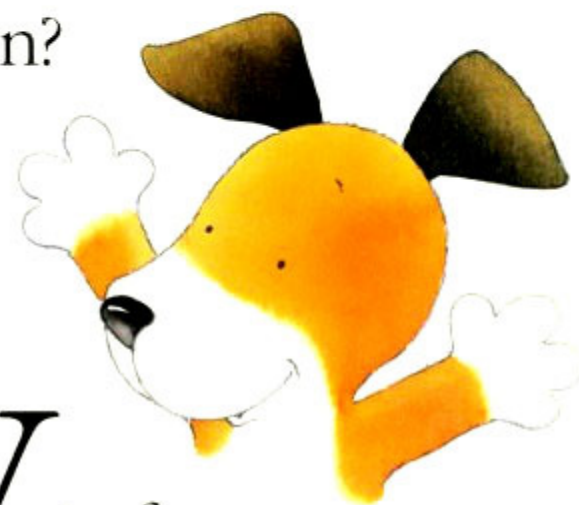


“It must be my turn

Is it?”

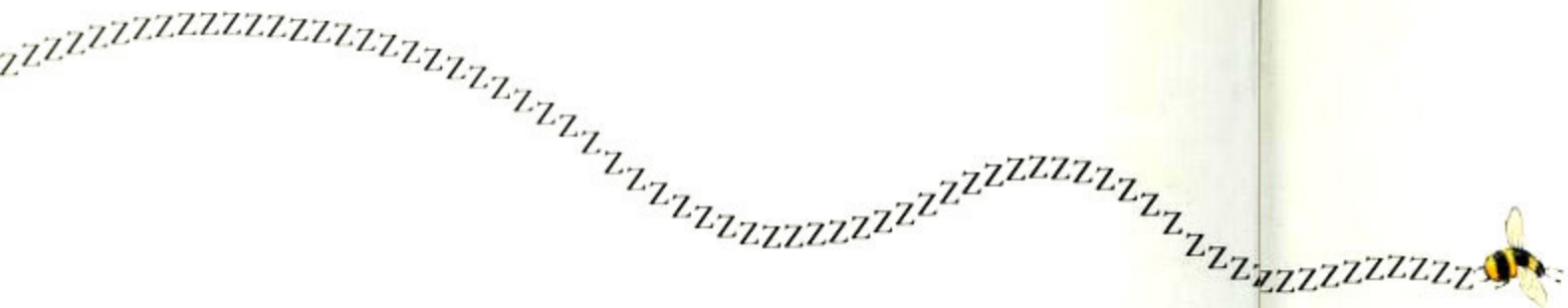


Yy is for
