# PASTING JIGSAW PUZZLES

#### The aims and purpose of this book

This workbook was designed to help improve fine motor skills by providing colorful and fun jigsaw puzzles for children to cut and paste. There are 20 exercises in this book, and each consists of 2 pages – one for cutting and one for pasting. Children will cut out the parts from the full-color page. Then, by using the pictures, colors and shapes, they will paste the parts together on the next page to complete the picture.

In order to complete each illustration, your child will need to imagine the whole picture and judge if the parts are placed in the appropriate places. Repeating these exercises will improve your child's spatial reasoning.

These exercises begin with simple shapes and pictures that consist of only 4 parts to cut and paste. The number of parts increases slowly as the pictures become more complex. This incremental method enables children to learn necessary techniques without difficulty.

If your child has difficulty cutting out challenging shapes, or deciding where to paste the parts, you can offer to help. The time you and your child spend together cutting and pasting will surely become a memorable experience for your child.



Please choose the right size and weight scissors fitted to your child's hand.

The line — on the left side of this book should be cut by parents, so please cut the page out and give it to your child before he or she starts the project.

There are 20 exercises in this book, and each consists of 2 pages – one for cutting and one for pasting.

Before placing glue on each piece, please encourage your child to arrange the pieces to make sure that they are arranged correctly.

Use glue sparingly. Please wait until the glue dries before allowing your child to play with what he or she has made.

Please refer to the "To parents" notes in this book, which provide more comments and advice on how to help your child progress through this book.

Most workbooks contain the same paper stock, but each Kumon Workbook features a different type of paper, tailored to a specific activity and use. This book features good, strong quality paper to help your child cut more easily.


