


Print, then color in as many pictures as you like. Ask a grown-up to help cut out the shapes. To determine how much string, ribbon or yarn you will need, place all of the finished pieces in a line and measure. Be sure to add about an inch or two for spacing in between the shapes and several inches at both ends for tying. You will also need a hole punch or a pen.


Punch holes where indicated on the shapes. If you don't have a hole punch, ask an adult to make the holes carefully with a ball point pen.



Next, thread each shape onto your ribbon keeping the longest sections of ribbon on the back of each shape. If the shapes are loose and don't stay in place on the banner, add a piece of tape to the back of each to secure the ribbon to the paper.

can even hang it outside!














Draw in the four life stages of a butterfly

1 Eggs

A butterfly lays her eggs on a plant, so that the caterpillars will have something to eat when they hatch.

2 Caterpillar

The job of a caterpillar is to eat, eat! Caterpillars can grow up to two inches long in just a few weeks.

3 Chrysalis

The caterpillar attaches itself upside down to a twig and transforms into a chrysalis to protect it while it turns into a butterfly.

⁴ Butterfly

When the butterfly hatches from its chrysalis, it becomes time to mate and find a place to lay eggs.




Cut out all pieces on the dotted lines.

If needed, glue the extra strip to make the band larger.


