
Boots and I are going to walk to Play Park. We called all of our friends to meet us there. We have strawberry cupcakes to share with everyone. Let's go!

How can we climb over the wall without letting all the cupcakes fall?




Boots and I will work together.

If Boots crawls up on my shoulders, then he will be tall enough to put the cupcakes safely on top of the wall.




Yeah!
