



One day, **Clark** and his sister, **Cleo**, went to **Clovis** Park.






They **climbed** a hill and had a picnic **close** to a pretty lake.





Clark and **Cleo** thought the **clam** chowder was especially delicious!






After a while, a **cluster** of **clouds cluttered** the **clear** sky.





"Guess what I see?" said **Clark**, staring up at the **clouds**. "Here is a **clue**: He has a round nose and **clomps** around in huge shoes."






"You see a **clown**!" said **Cleo**.


"Very clever!" exclaimed Clark.





Another **cluster** of **clouds** appeared. "Guess what I see?" said **Cleo**. "Here is a **clue**: You hang them up in a **closet**."






"You see clothes!" said Clark.

"Very clever!" exclaimed Clark.






