
I wish I could **fly** like the other **flamingos**.


Fluffy little Flora Flamingo cannot fly.








Flora is upset. She wants to fly to the flamingo festival in Florida with the rest of the flamingo flock.





Flora watches the butterflies. They flutter from flower to flower.






Flora tries to fly like the butterflies. But it's no use.


Flap, flap, flap...flop. Flap, flap, flap...flop.





At night, **Flora** watches the **fireflies**. They **flicker** and **flash** as they **flit** through the air.






Flora tries to fly like the fireflies.

But it's no use.


Flap, flap, flap...flop. Flap, flap, flap...flop.






Flora's friend Floyd Flounder floats by. "I'm a flop at flying," Flora tells Floyd.






"Just be patient," says **Floyd**. "Soon you will **fly** like the rest of the **flamingo flock**." **Flora** hopes **Floyd** is right.






One morning, **Flora** wakes up. Her **fluff** is gone! Now she has **flashy** pink feathers!






Will the feathers help **Flora fly**? **Flap**, **flap**, **flap**...
