

house, Mouse!"






But that **mouse bounded** onto the **ground** and **bounced** off my shoe. "**OUCH**!" I **shouted**.


"Out of my house, Mouse!" I shouted.

And guess who was **lounging** beside me? The **mouse**!






When I looked at the **mouse**, he was trembling. Why, that **mouse** was not **lousy** at all! He was just scared.
