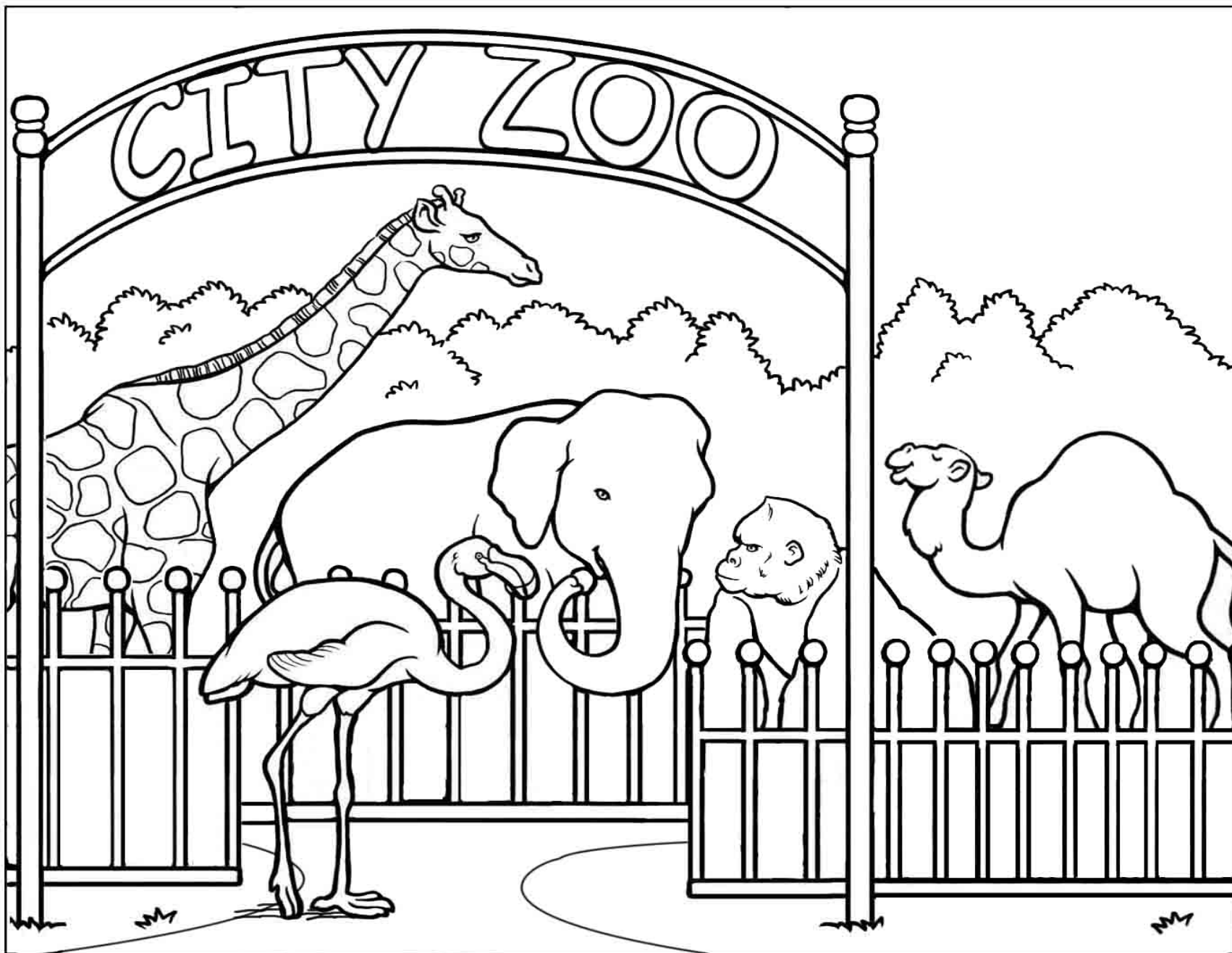



The Australian Koala



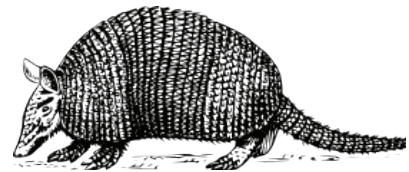
Even though the koala is often called a "koala bear", it's not a bear at all! It's a marsupial, a type of mammal that carries its babies in a pouch. The koala's main source of food is eucalyptus leaves. The baby koala, called a "joey", is born blind and hairless, and is the size of a jellybean. Koalas can live as long as 17 years.



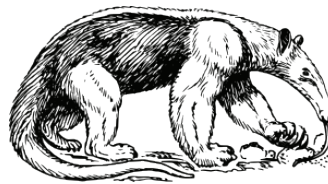
Animal Tracks: South America

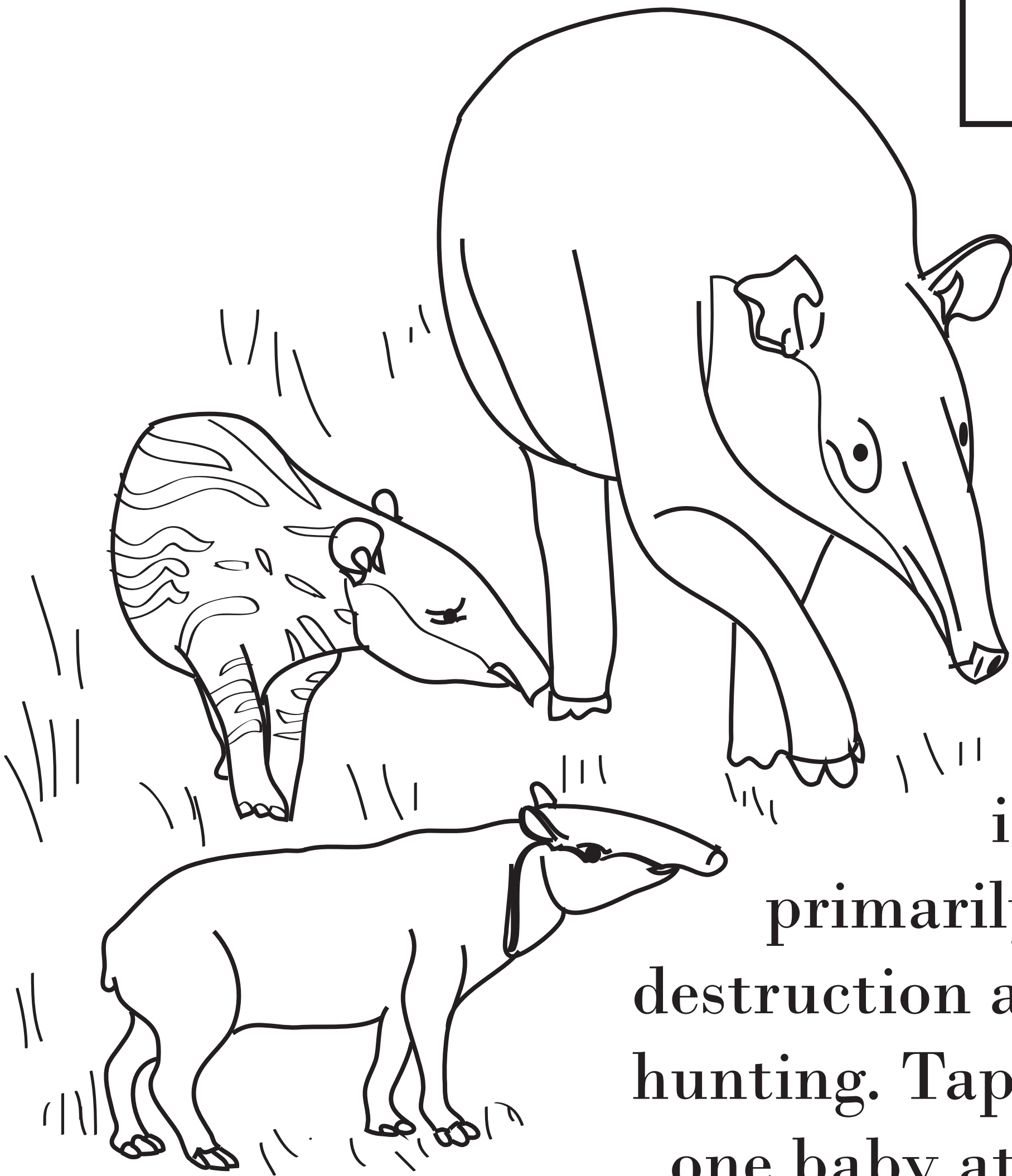


Endangered Species

Baird's Tapir

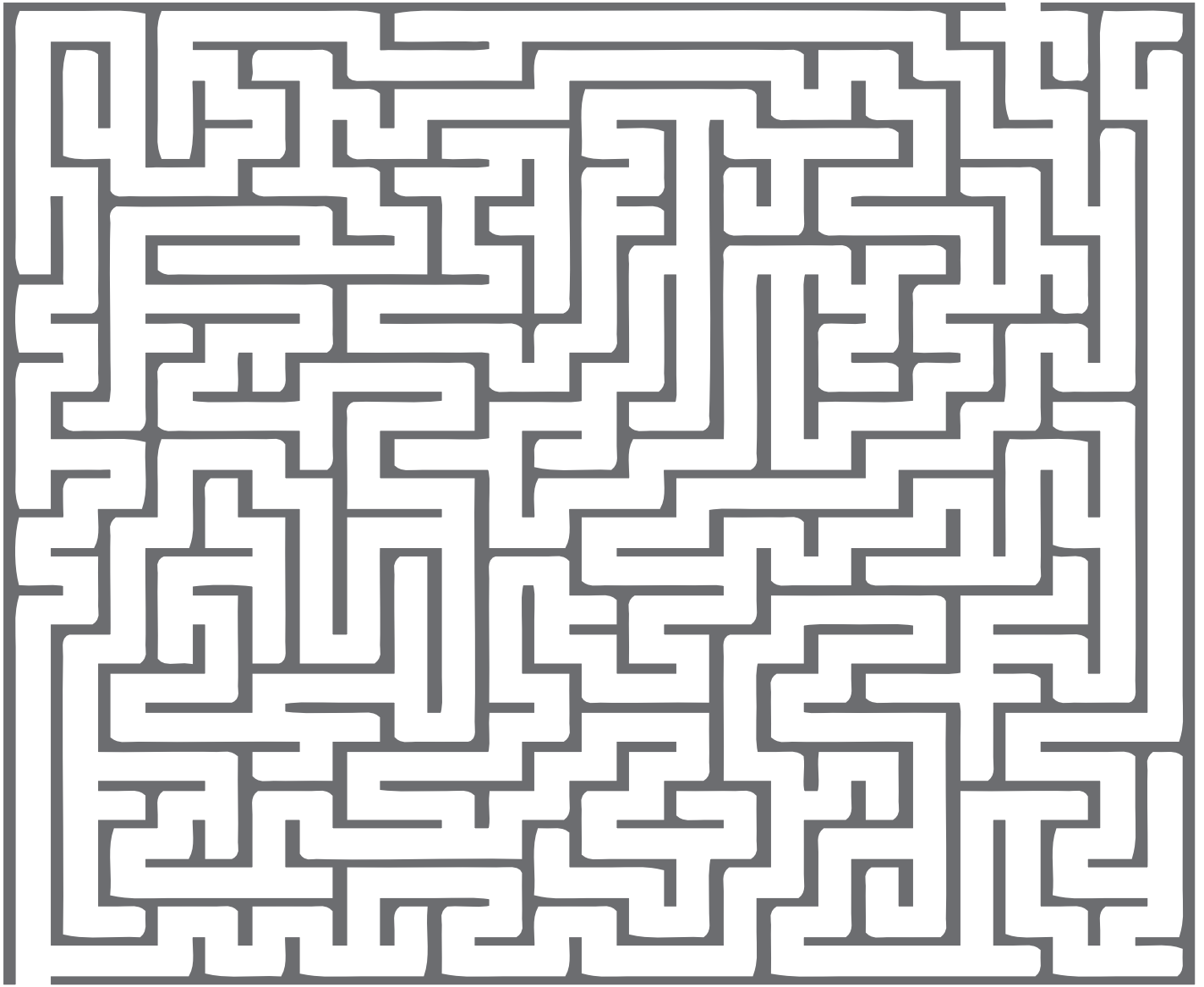
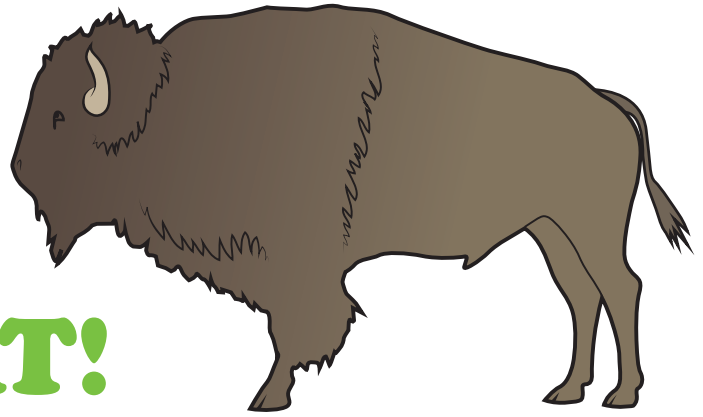
Tapirus bairdii

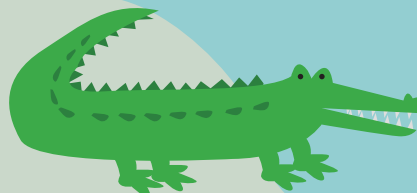

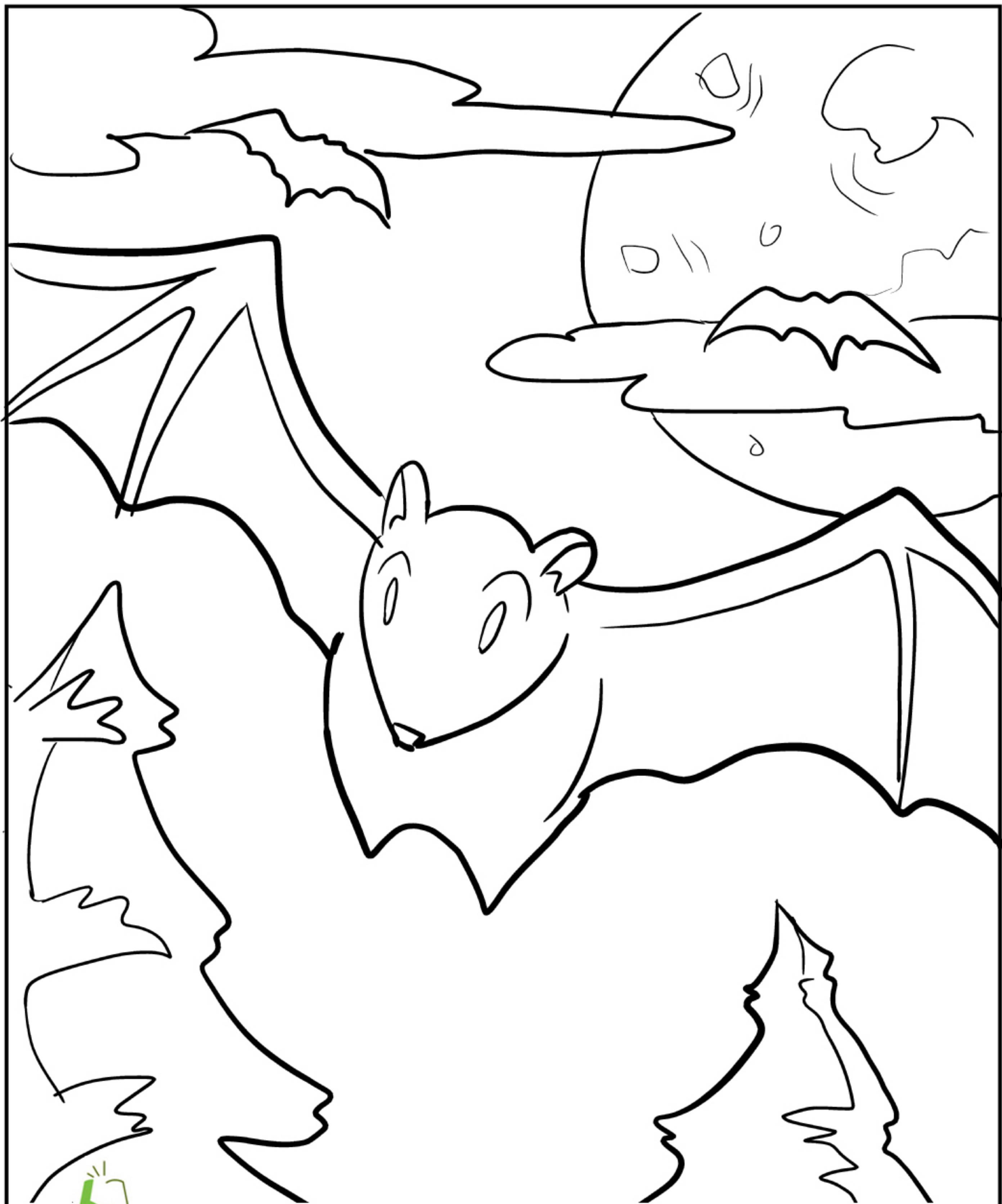

Australia, the Land Down Under



The Australian Sugar Glider



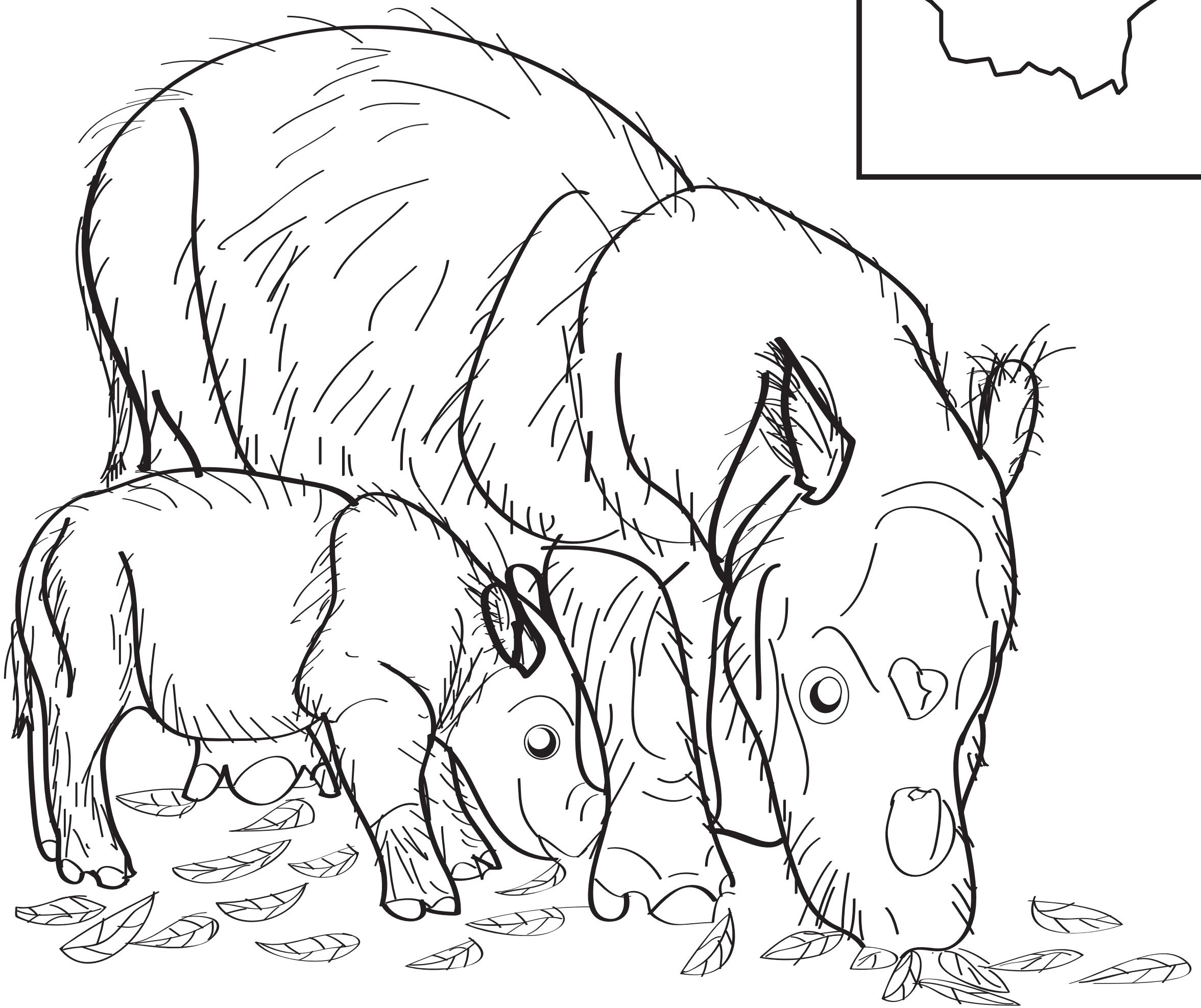
The sugar glider is native to eastern and northern mainland Australia. It is a small gliding possum (its body is 5-6 inches long) commonly found in forests with eucalyptus trees. They sleep in their nests during the day and are active at night when they hunt for insects and small vertebrates. They also feed on the sweet sap of certain species of eucalyptus, acacia and gum trees. Around the world, the sugar glider is a popular domestic pet.

The Sumatran Rhinoceros has only six populations, distributed throughout three islands near Indonesia, including Borneo, Sumatra and the Maylay Peninsula. They have long, shaggy hair that is reddish-brown. There are only an estimated 275 animals left in the wild. They are threatened mainly by deforestation, and by poachers, who can sell the horns for high prices.
