
This is Country Mouse's home. One day his friend, Town Mouse, comes to see him.

'Please have some more,' says Country Mouse.


'It's very nice,' says Town Mouse, 'but no thank you.'

Country Mouse gives Town Mouse his bed. 'You can have my bed tonight,' he says. 'Thank you,' says Town Mouse.




But Country Mouse's bed is strange.

There's a cow in the field.




'Oh!' cries Town Mouse. 'What's that?'
'It's only a cow!' laughs Country Mouse.




'Do you like the country?' asks Country Mouse.

'Listen,' says Town Mouse. 'That cart's going to town. Come on.'






There's a lot to eat. But Country Mouse thinks the food is strange.

'Please have some more,' says Town Mouse.


'It's very nice,' says Country Mouse, 'but no thank you.'

At last the cat goes away. The two mice are very hungry.


Suddenly, Country Mouse sees something.

'Look!' he shouts. 'Cheese!'


'STOP!' shouts Town Mouse. 'Don't touch that! It's a trap!'

'Write to me,' says Town Mouse.




Soon Country Mouse is home. He's in the country. He sits by the fire.


'Ah!' he says happily. 'It's good to be home again.'
