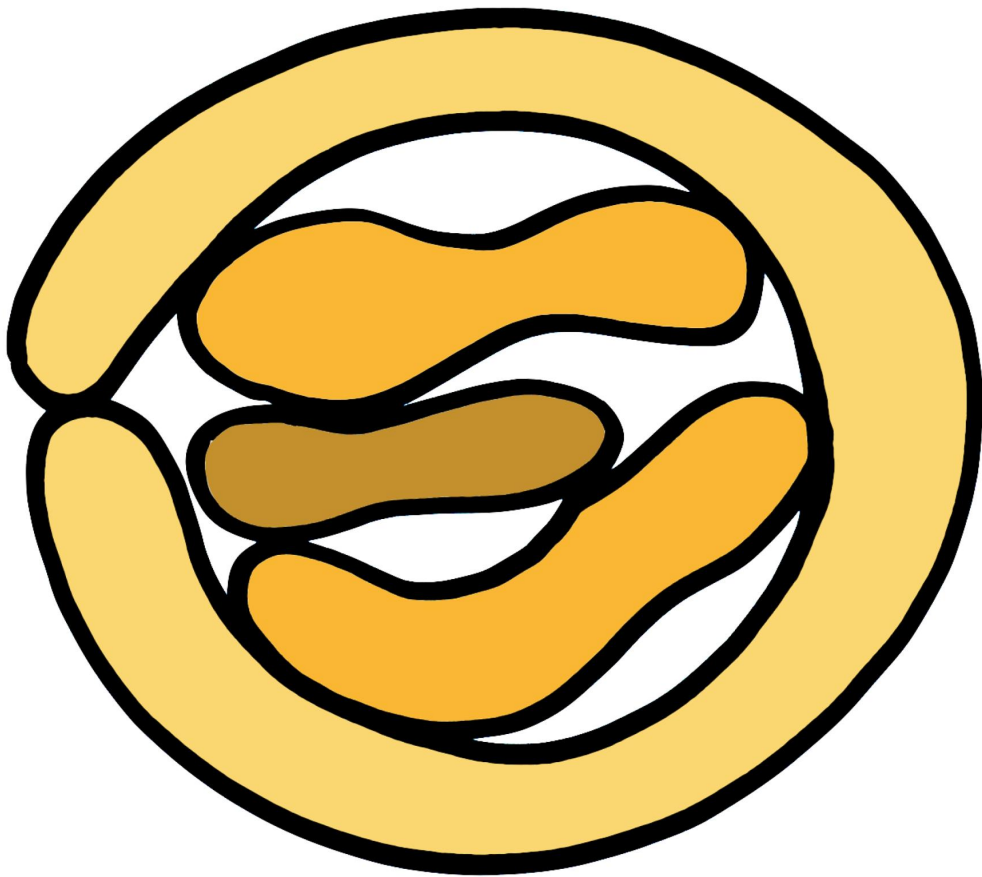

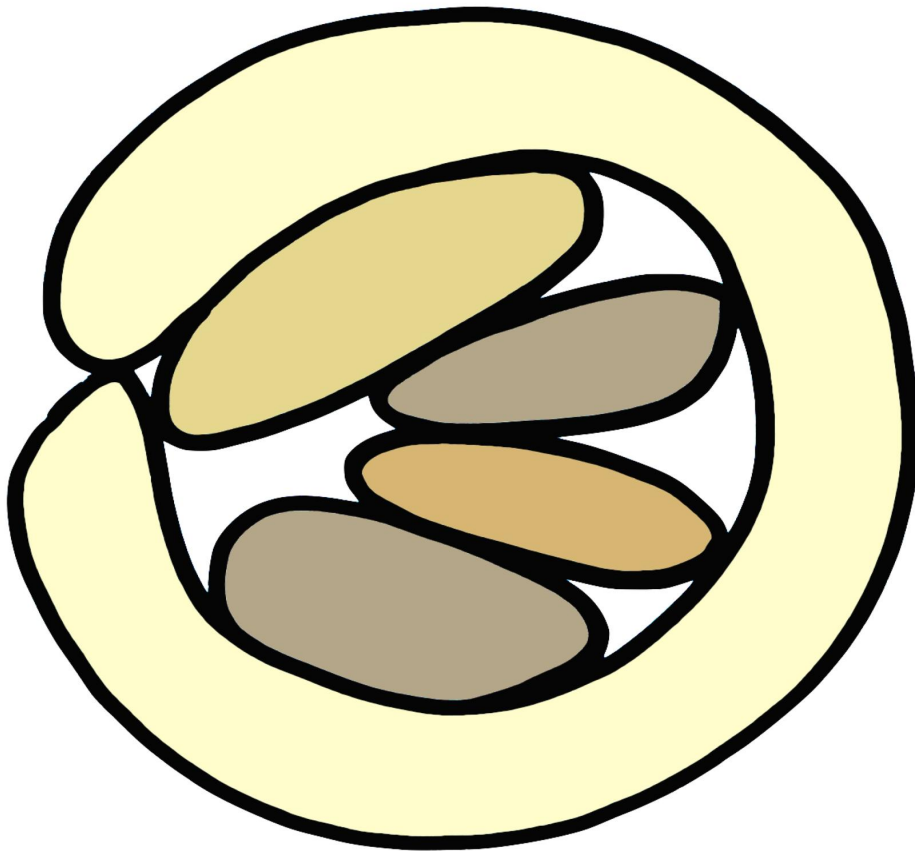
MERCURY

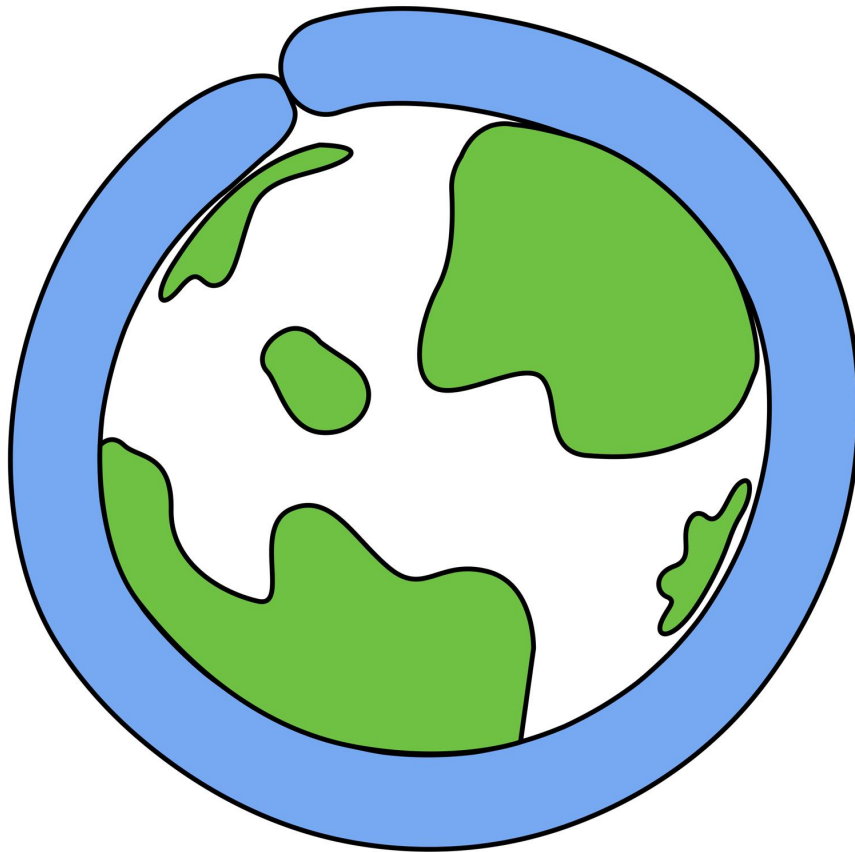
VENUS

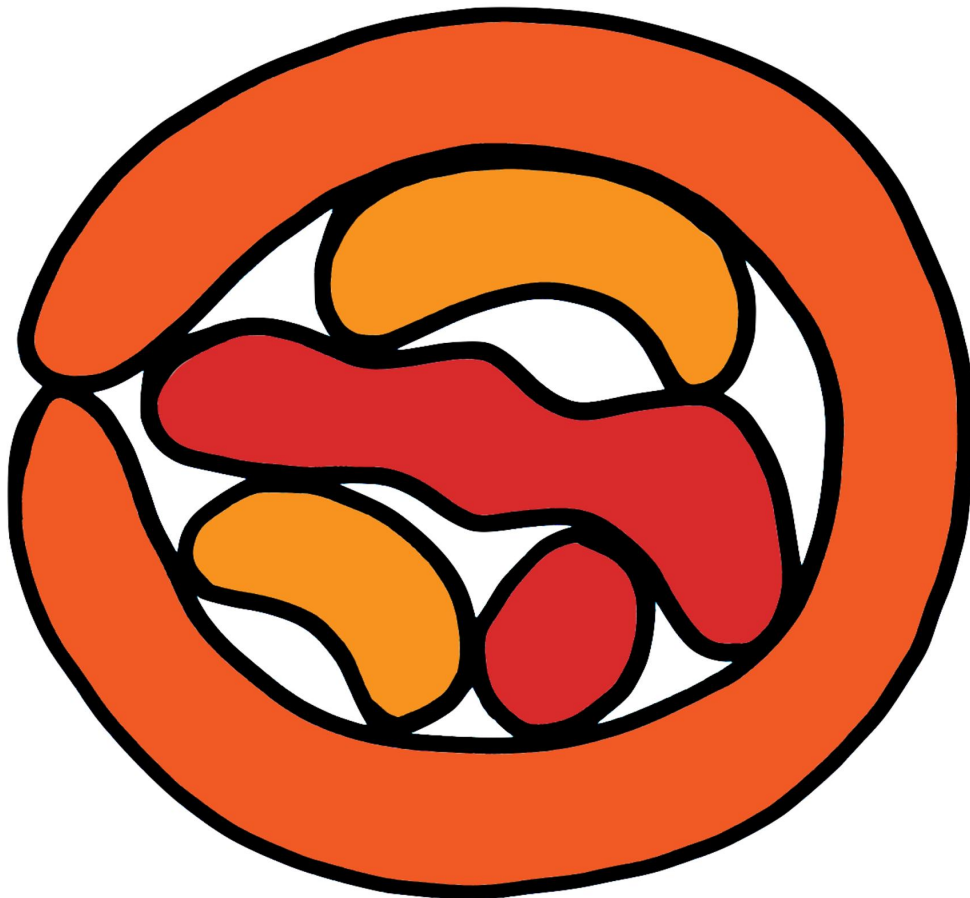
EARTH

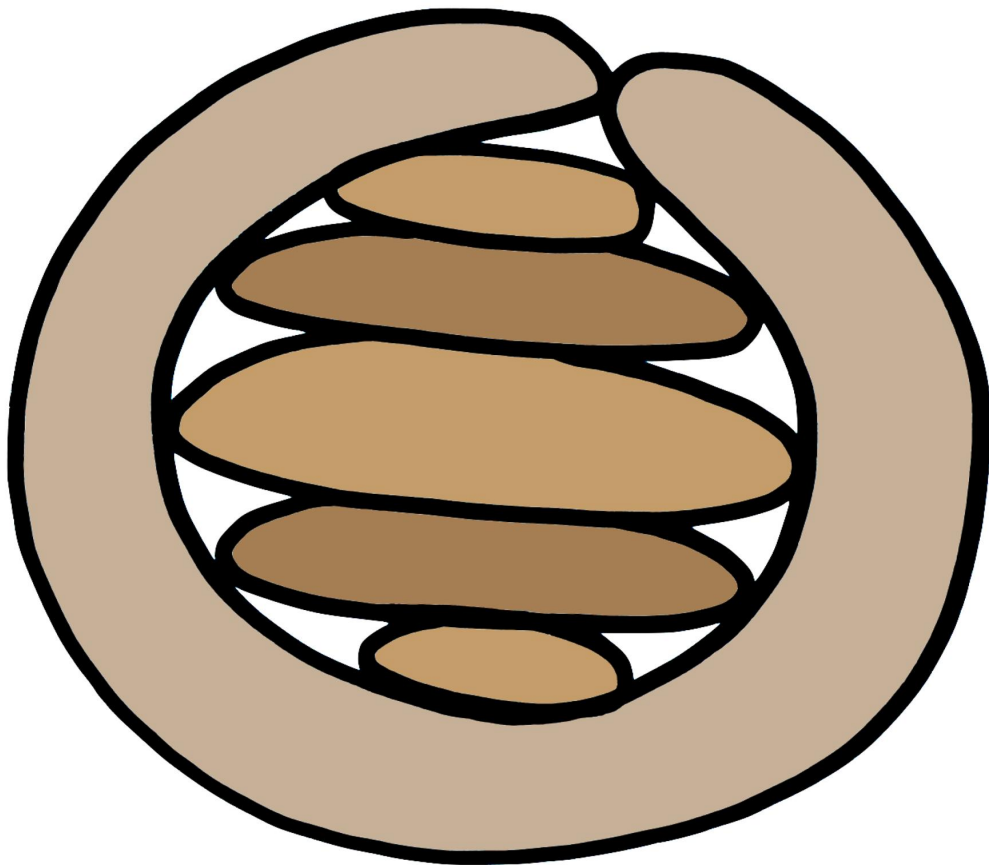
MARS

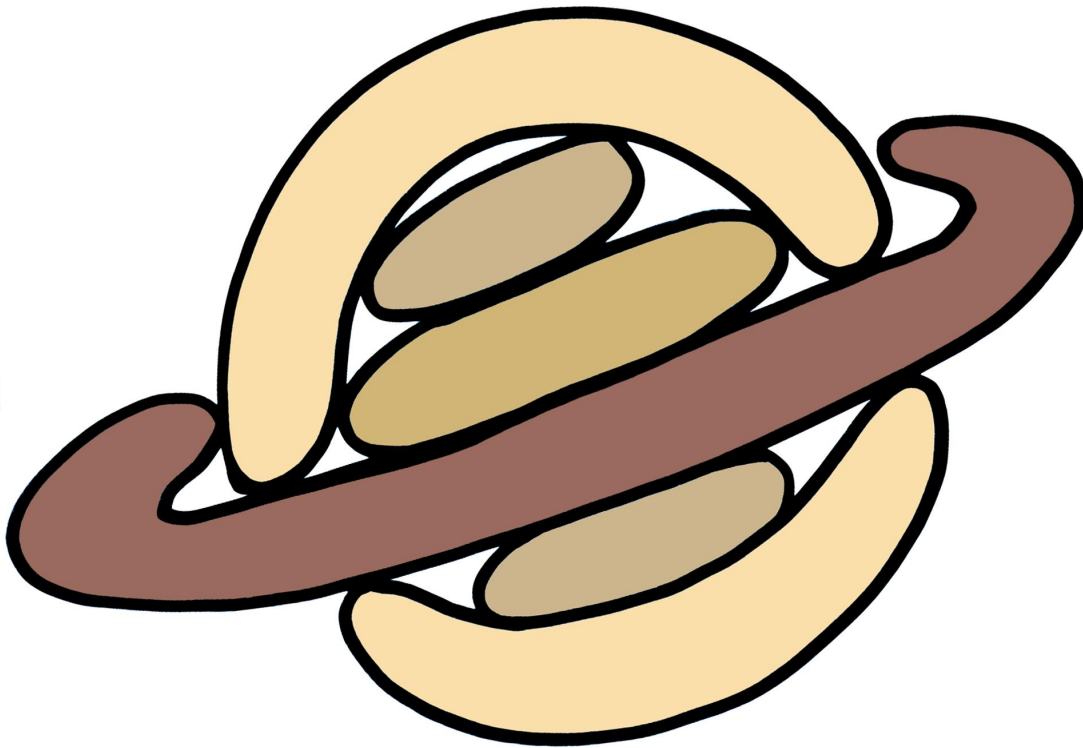
JUPITER

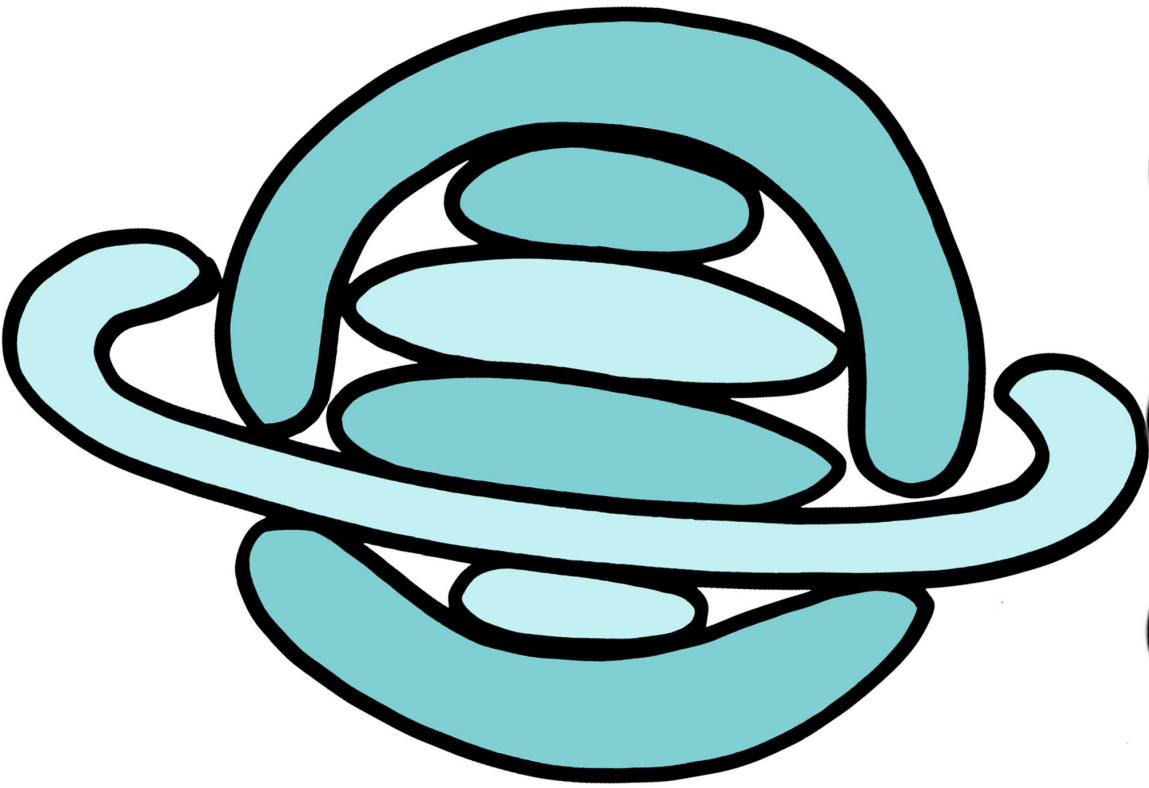
SATURN

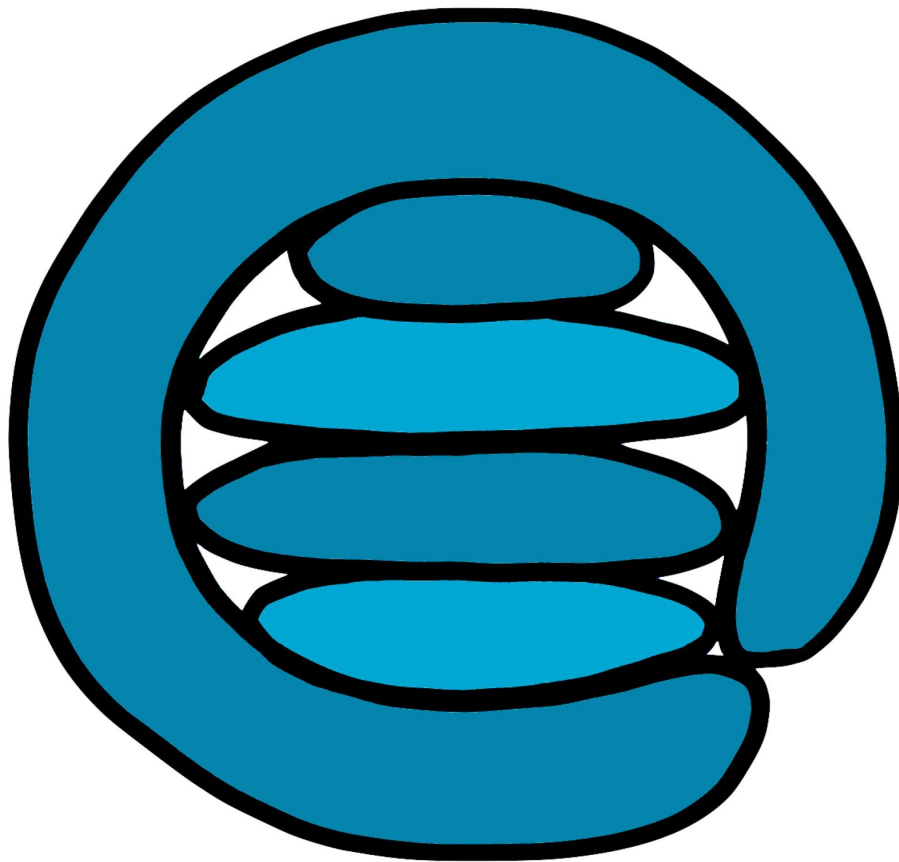
URANUS

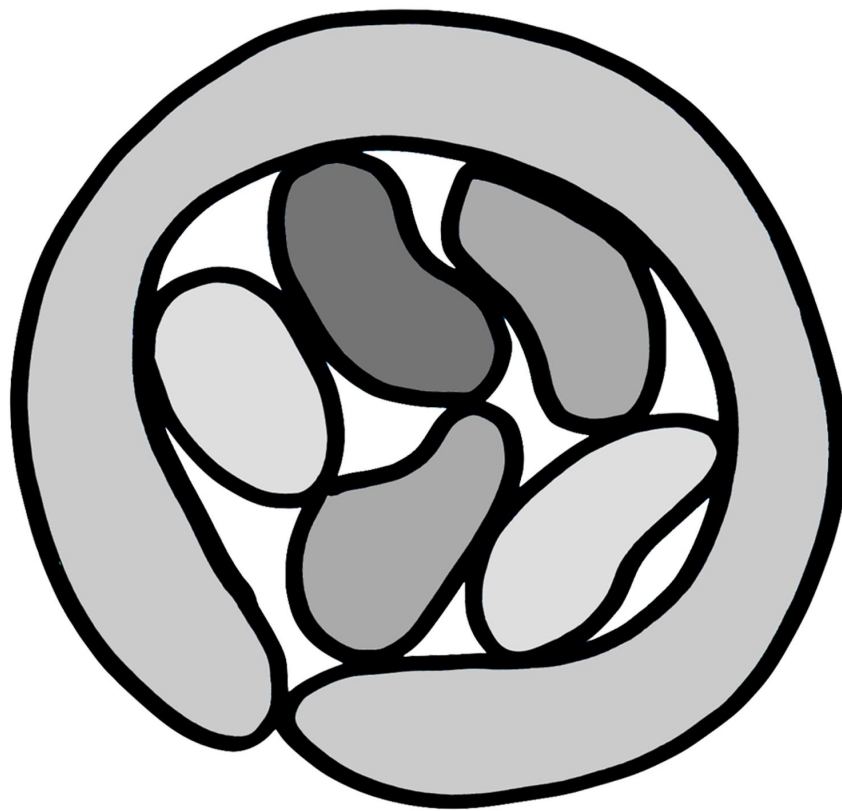
NEPTUNE

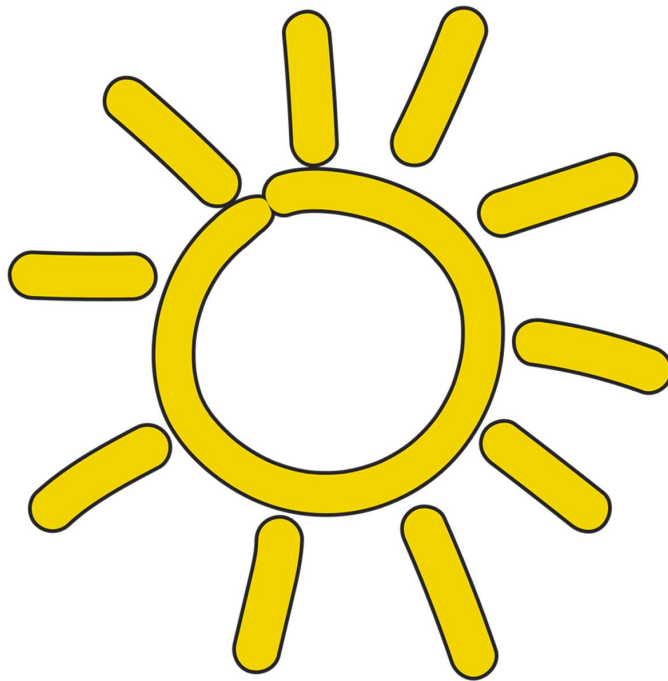
MOON

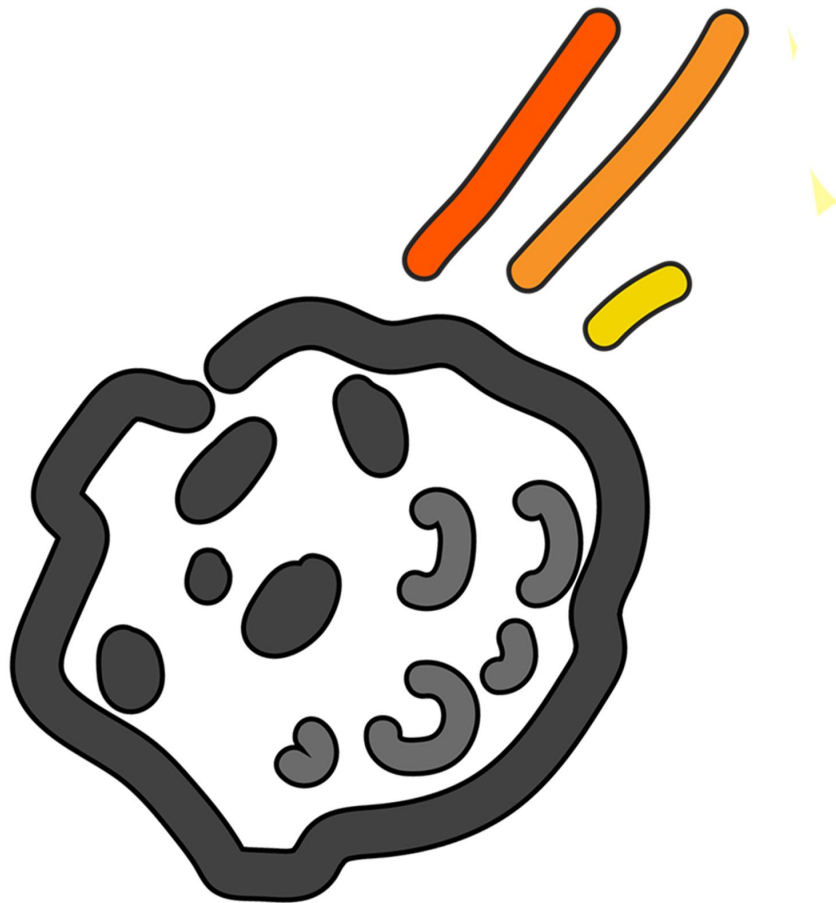
SUN

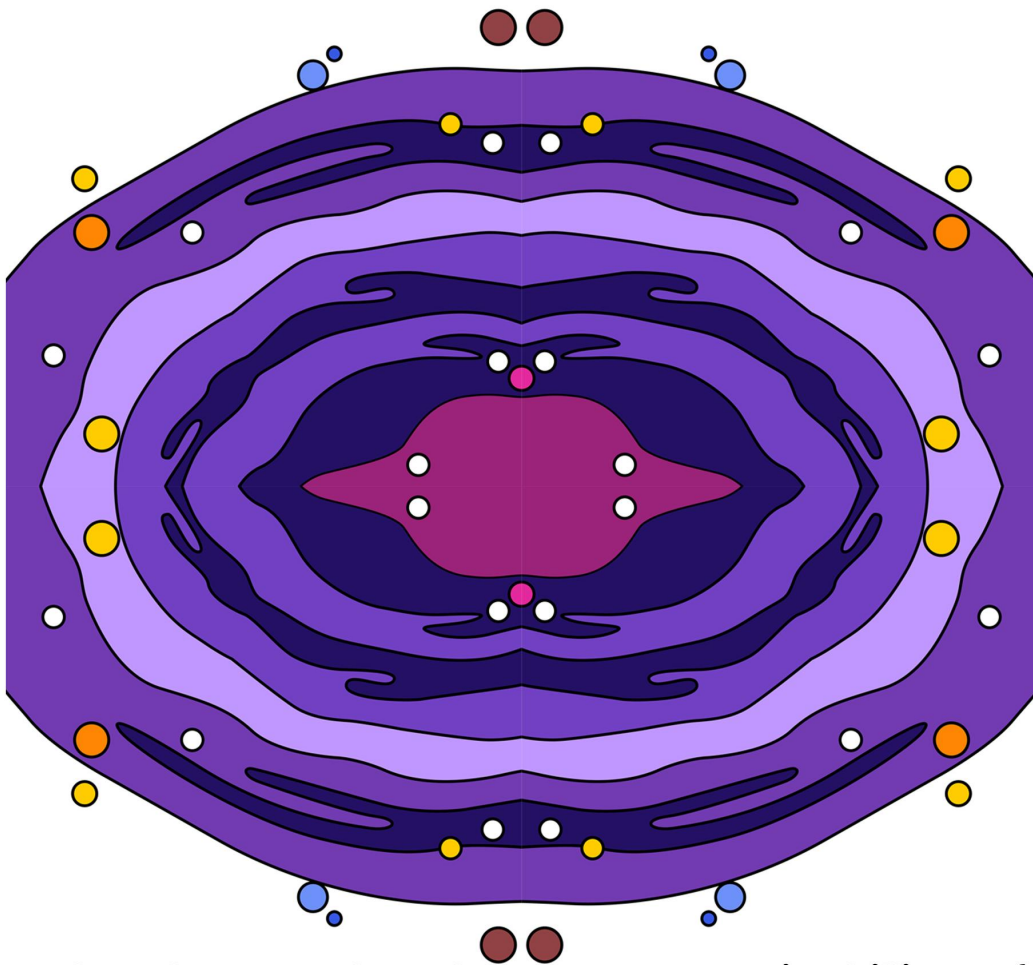
ASTEROID



Asteroids are rocky objects that orbit the Sun, ranging in size from small boulders to large bodies.

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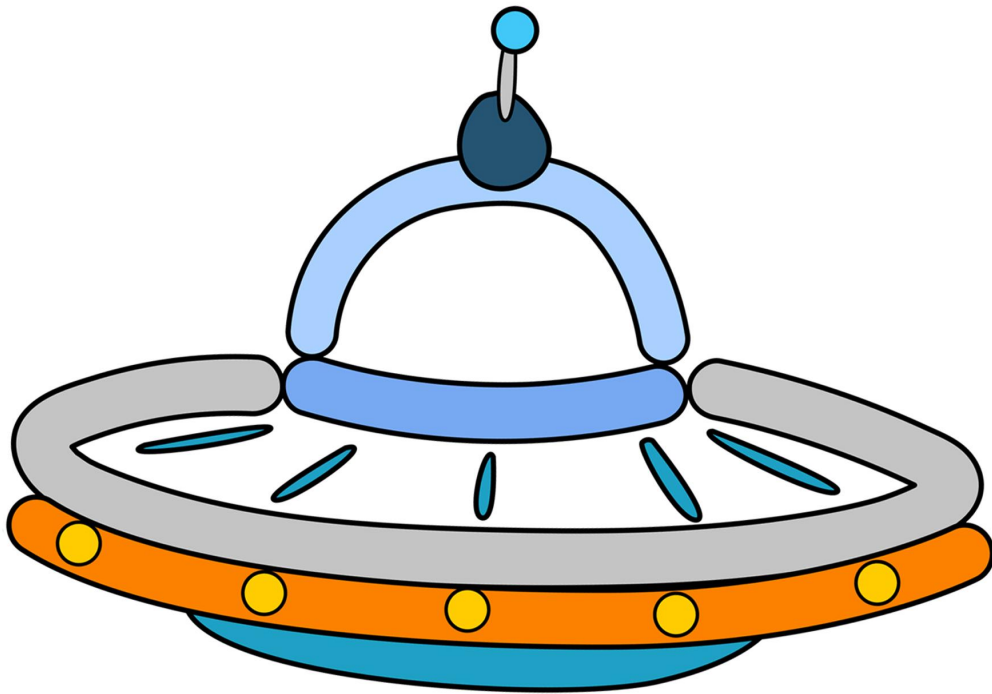
GALAXY

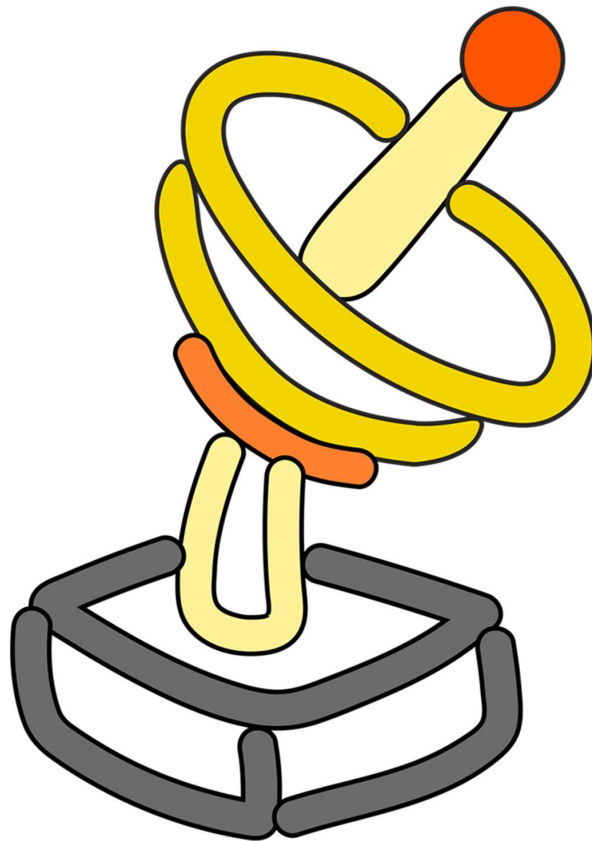
SPACESHIP

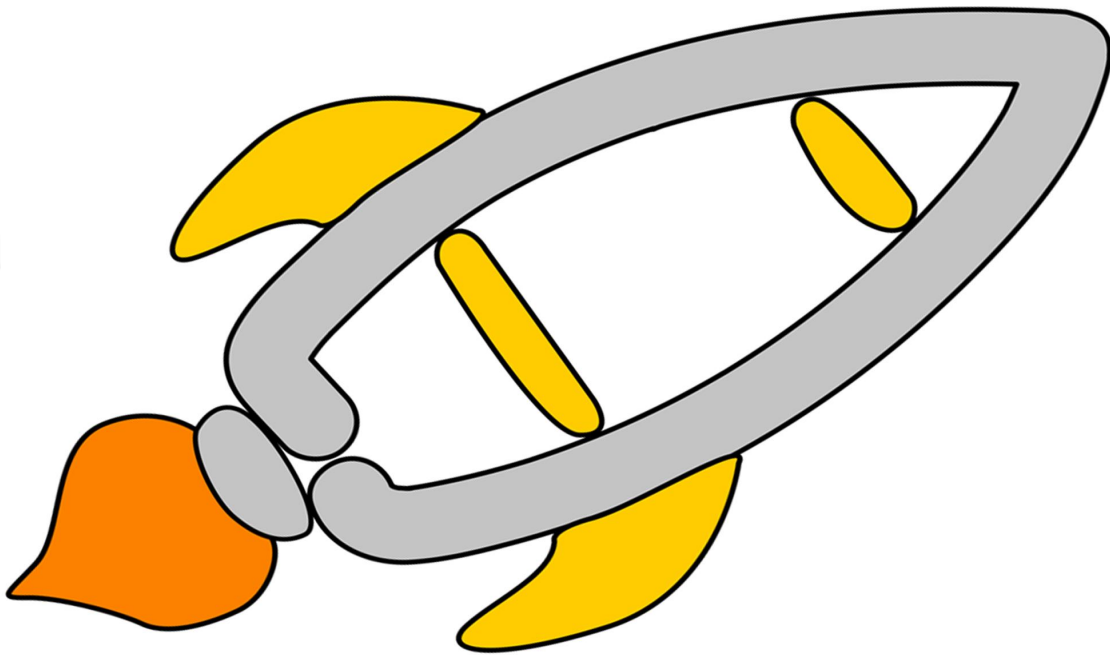
SATELLITE

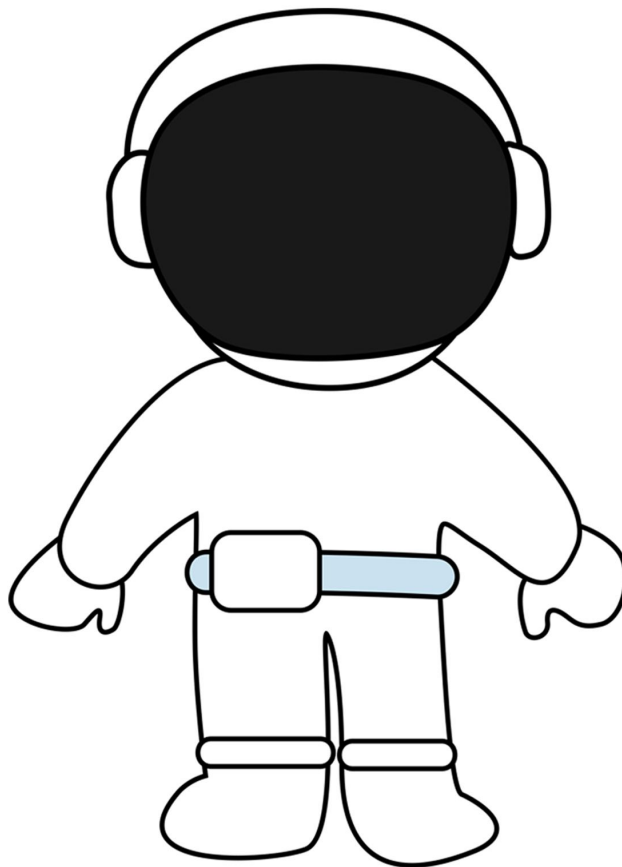
ROCKET
