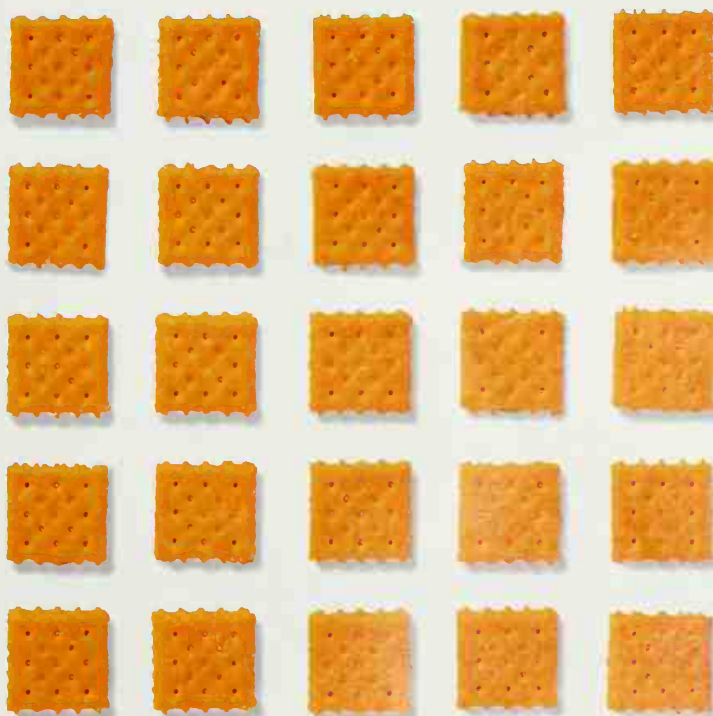


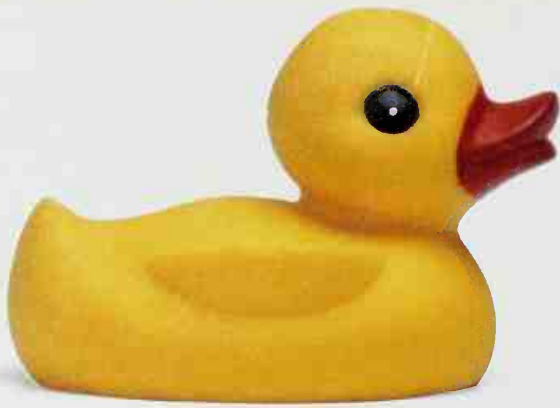
Building blocks, windows, and game boards are square.

Take a look at these rows of three.



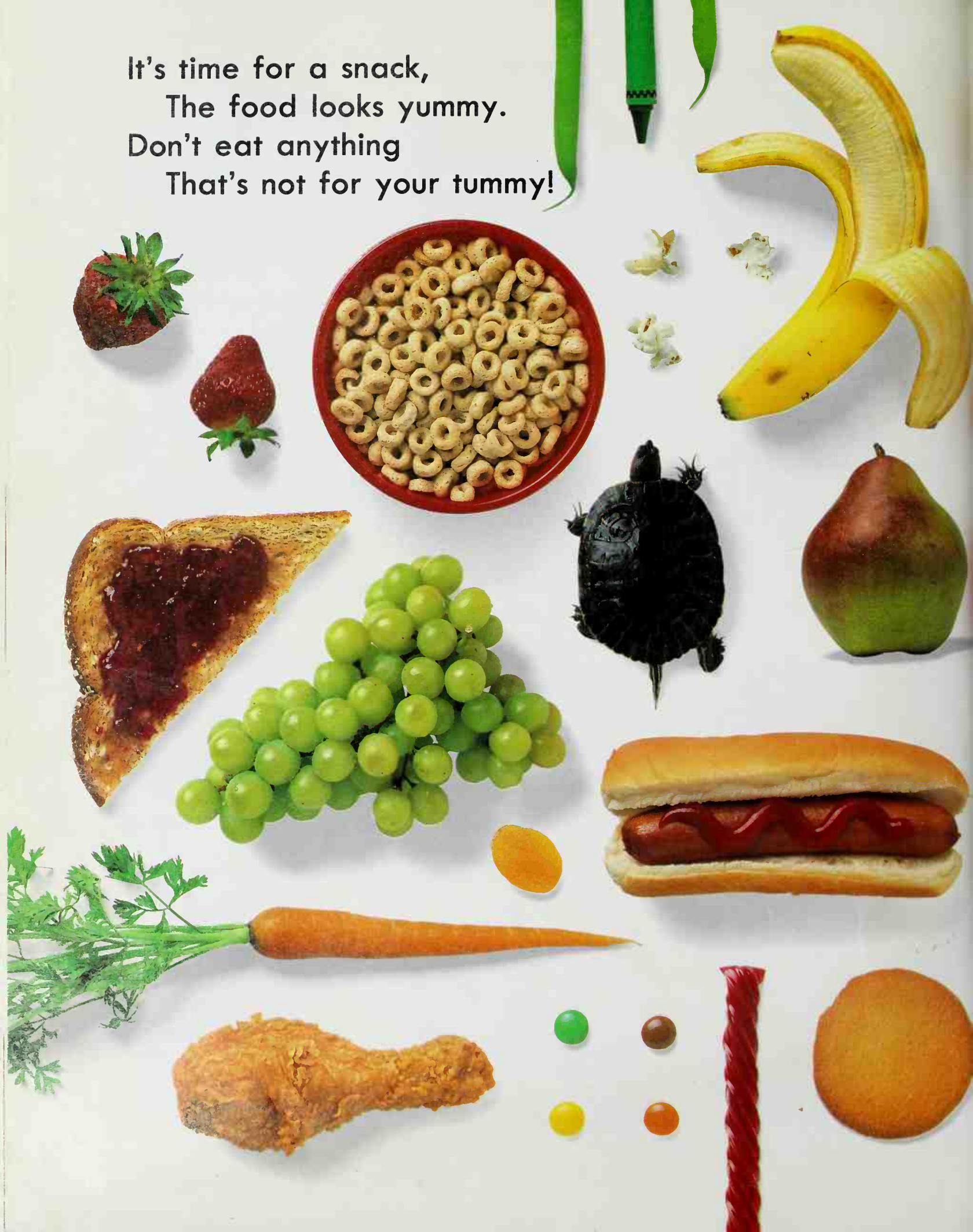

Can you find what made the boy's hair sudsy?



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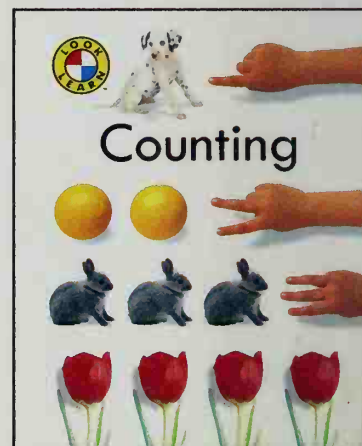
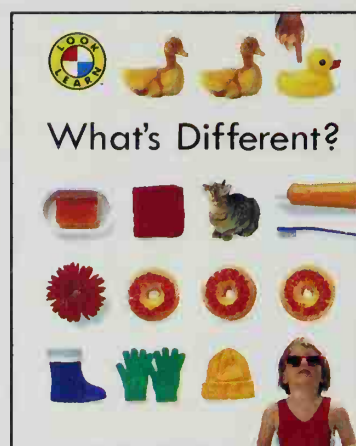
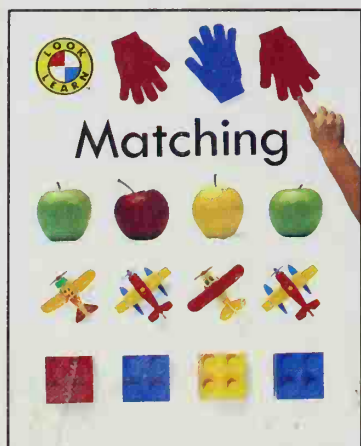
