


Right side up and upside down,

Someone's feet aren't on the ground!


Who is it?















A tisket, a tasket!









Who's shopping with a basket?






Building blocks, windows, and game boards are square.








One shape is different. It can fly in the air. What is it?





Can you find what made the boy's hair sudsy?














