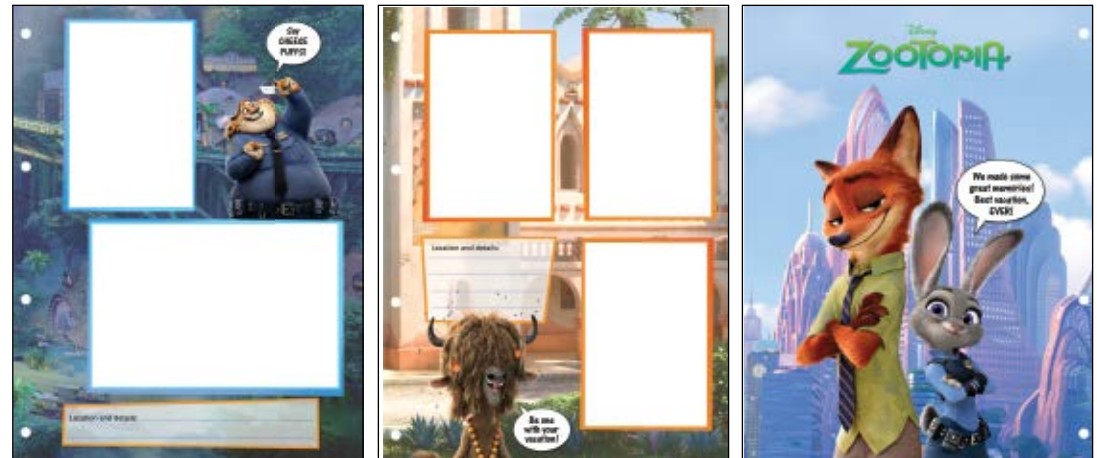




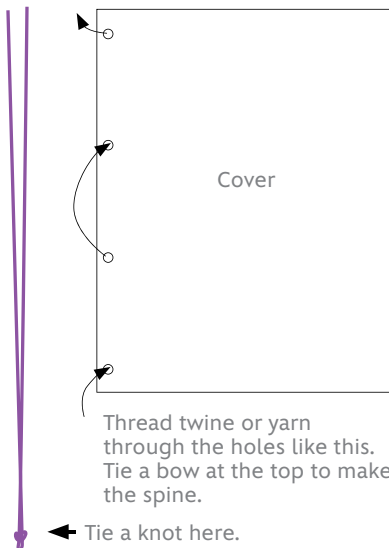
What you will need:

How to make the spine:

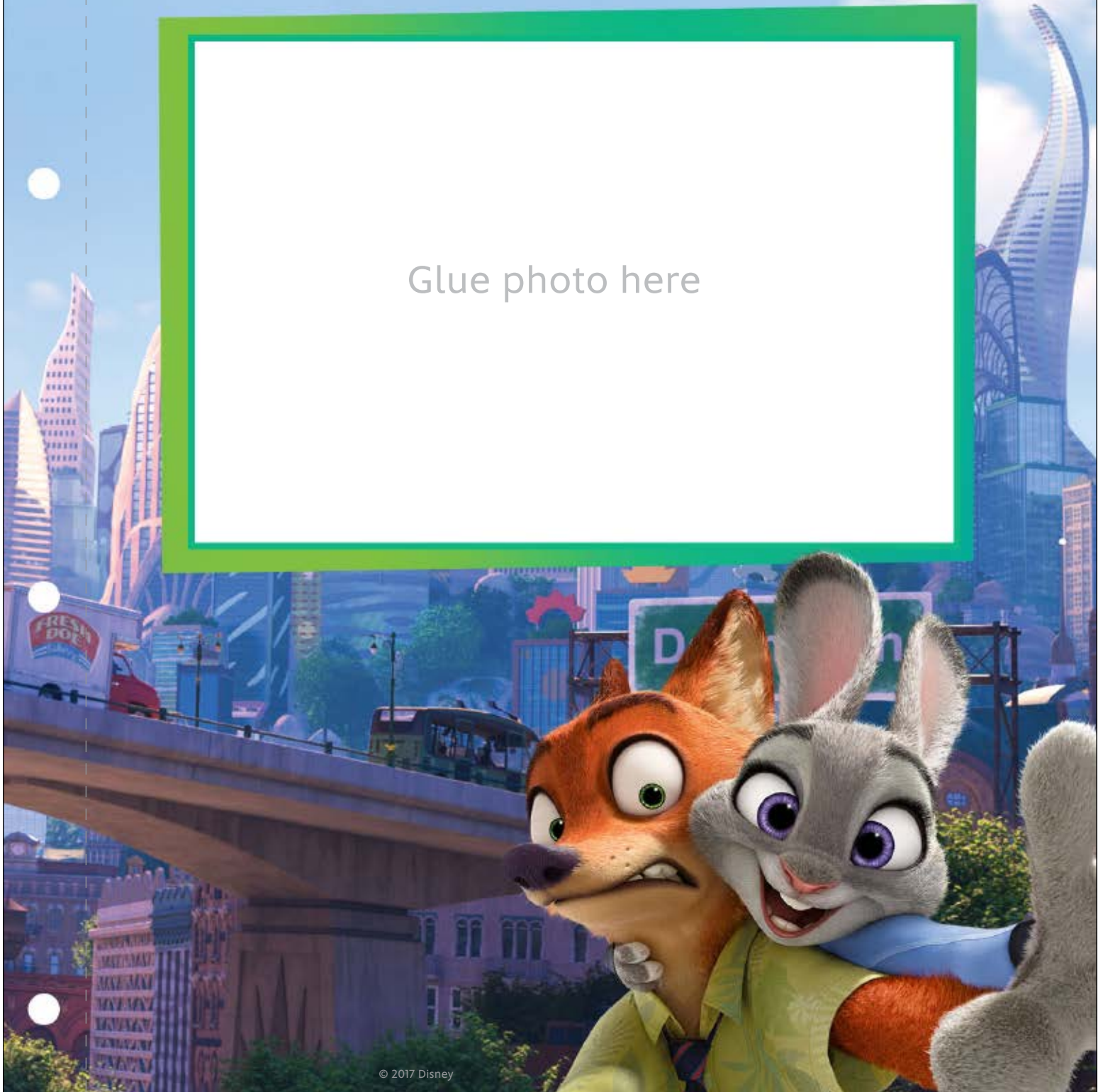


Sticker pages



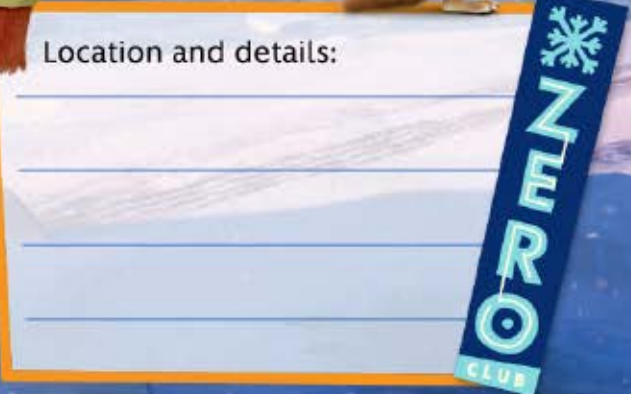

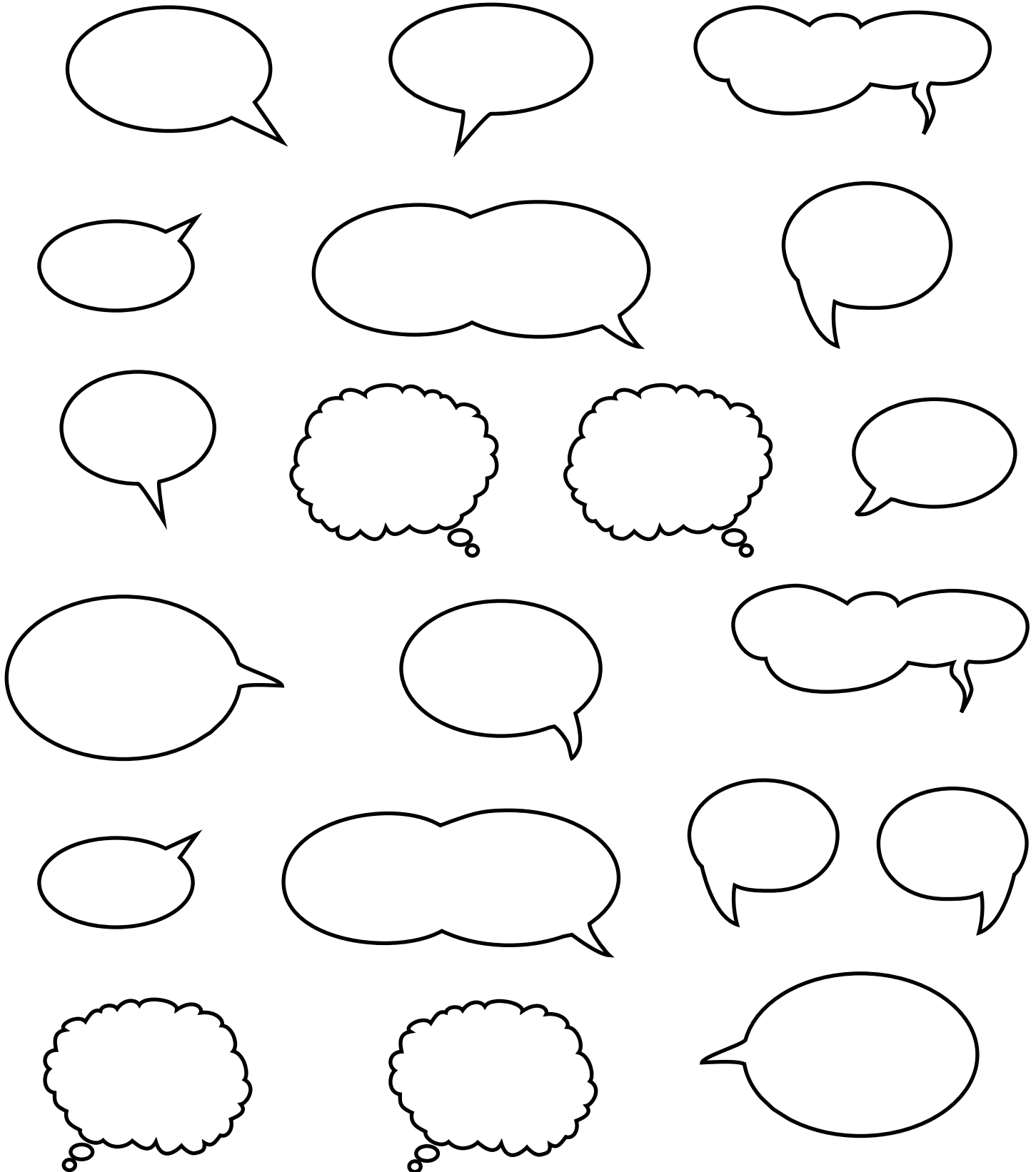
