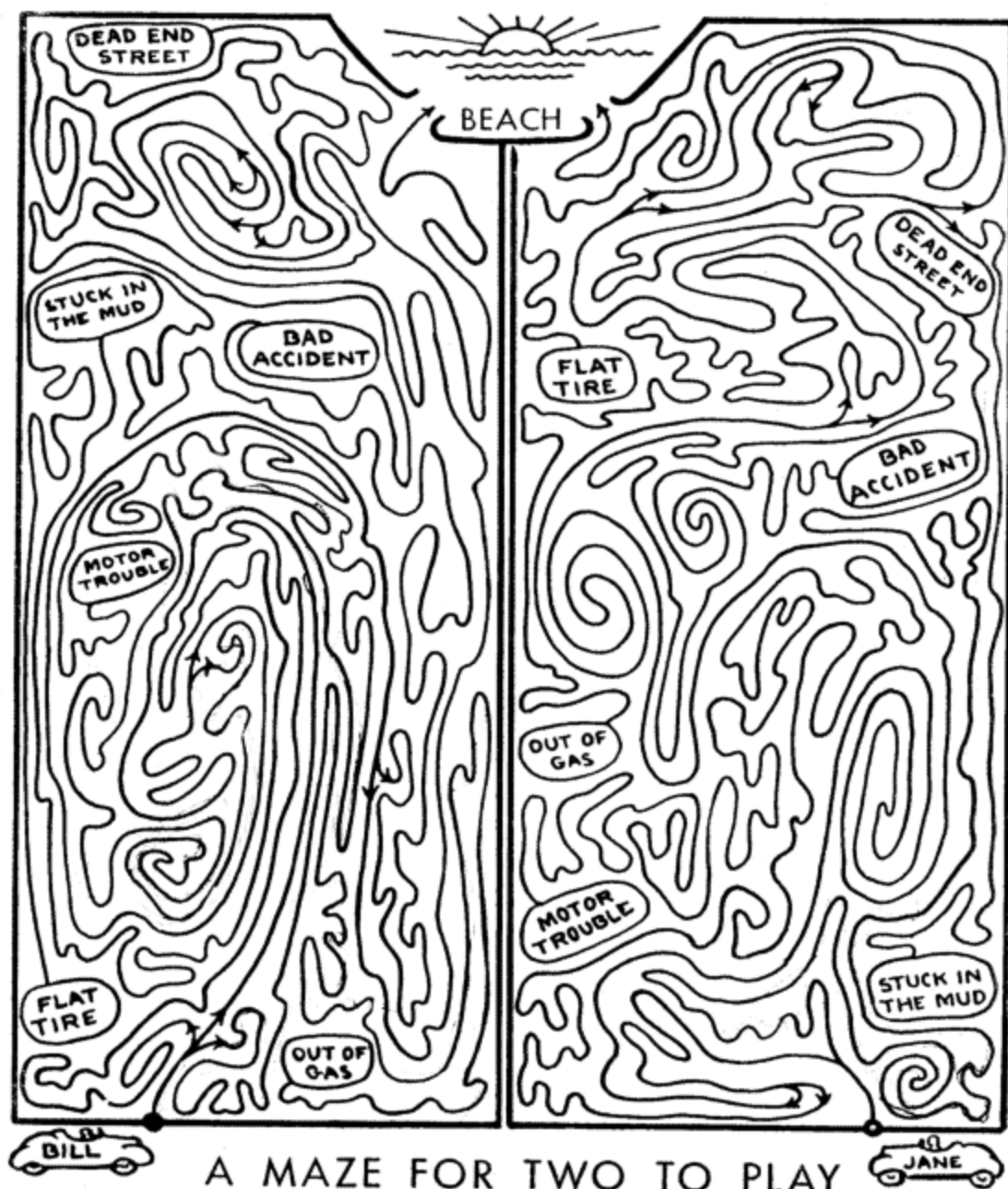


# THE MOUSE-TRAP MAZE



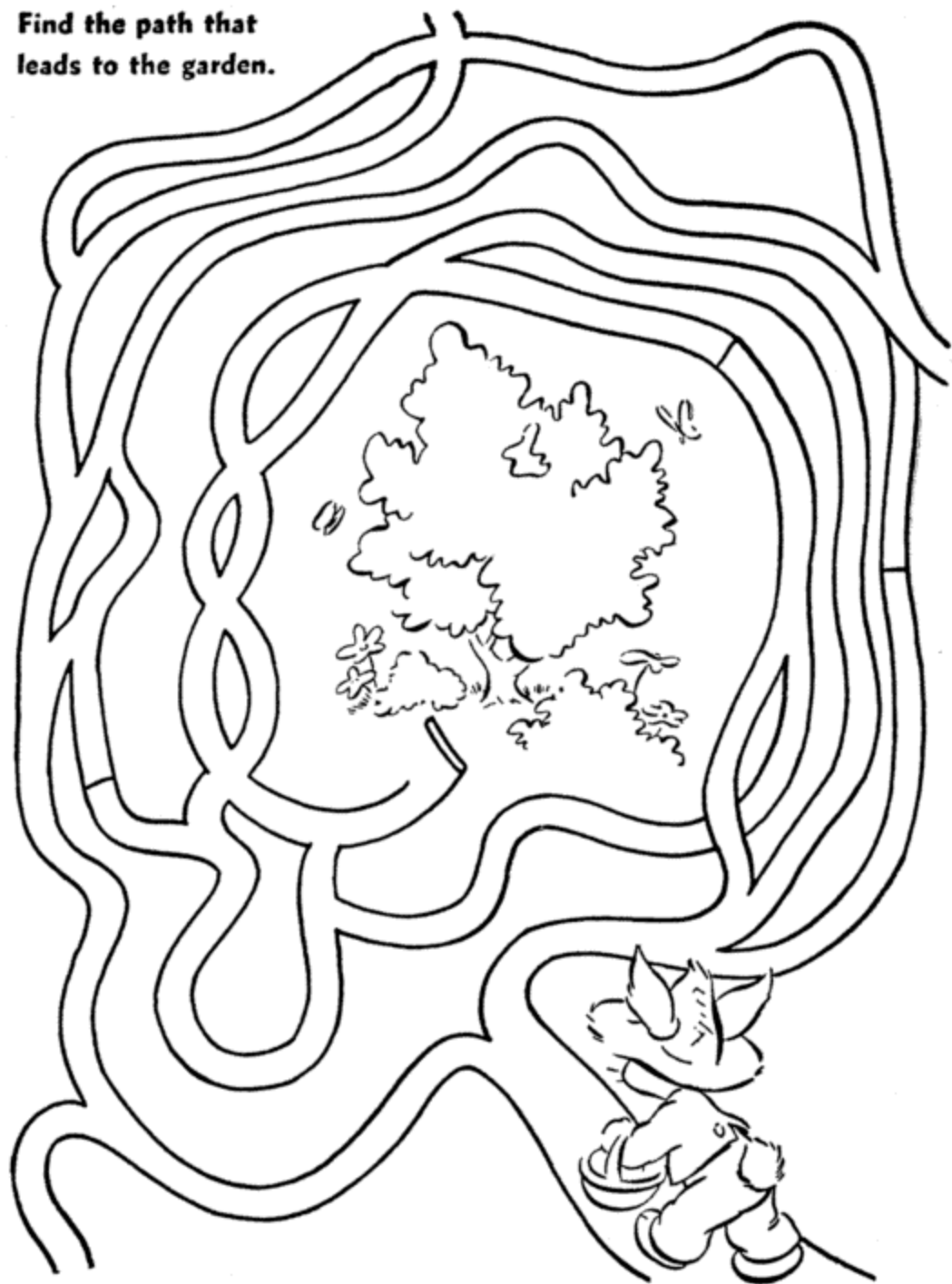

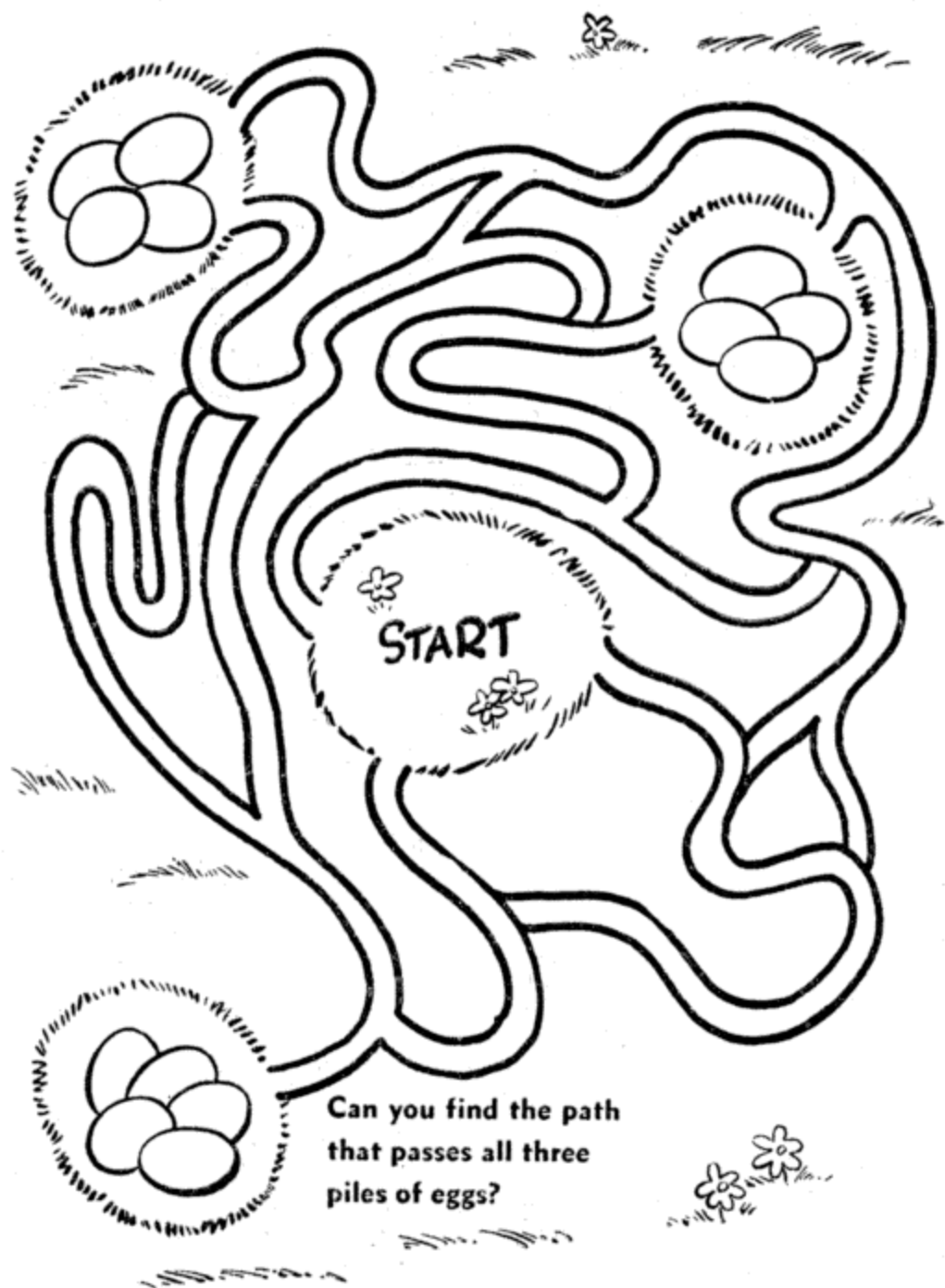
