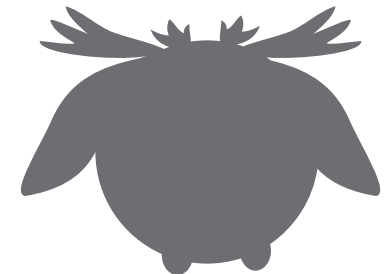
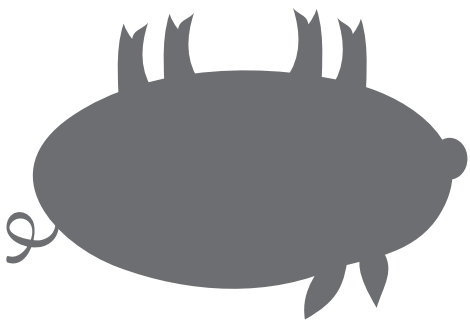
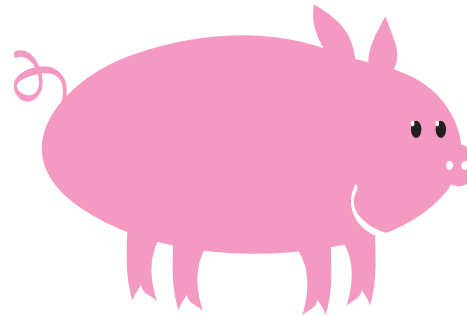
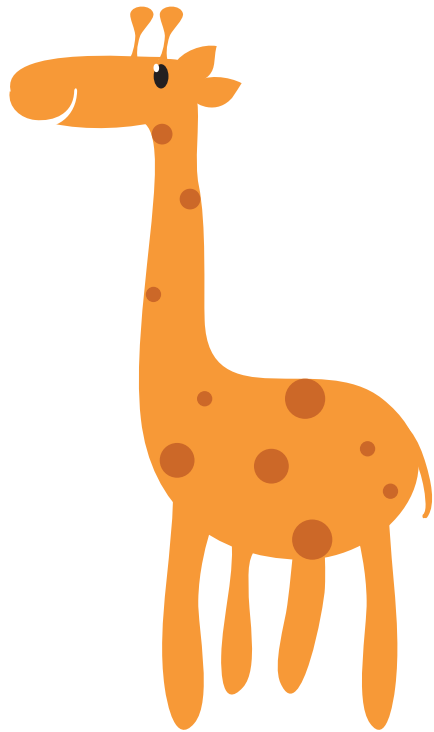
Planting Vegetables in the Garden

Parent Tip: Talk about how plants grow & stages of planting. Ask the child to name more vegetables.

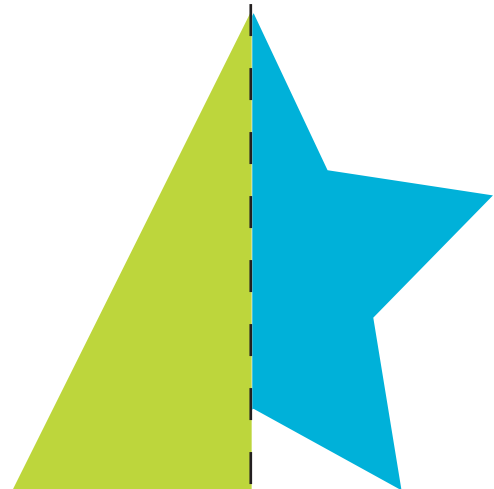
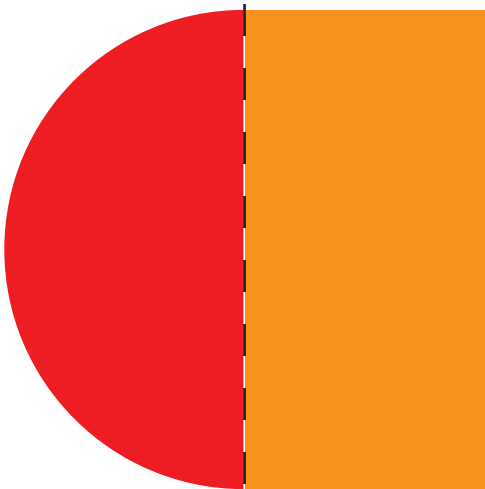
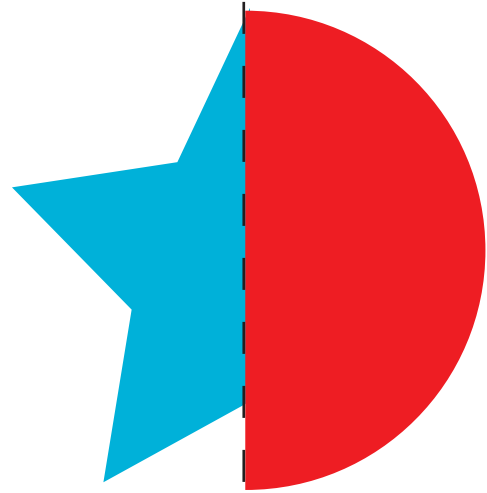
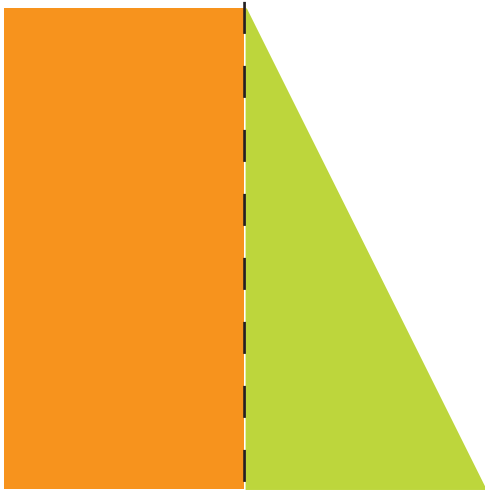


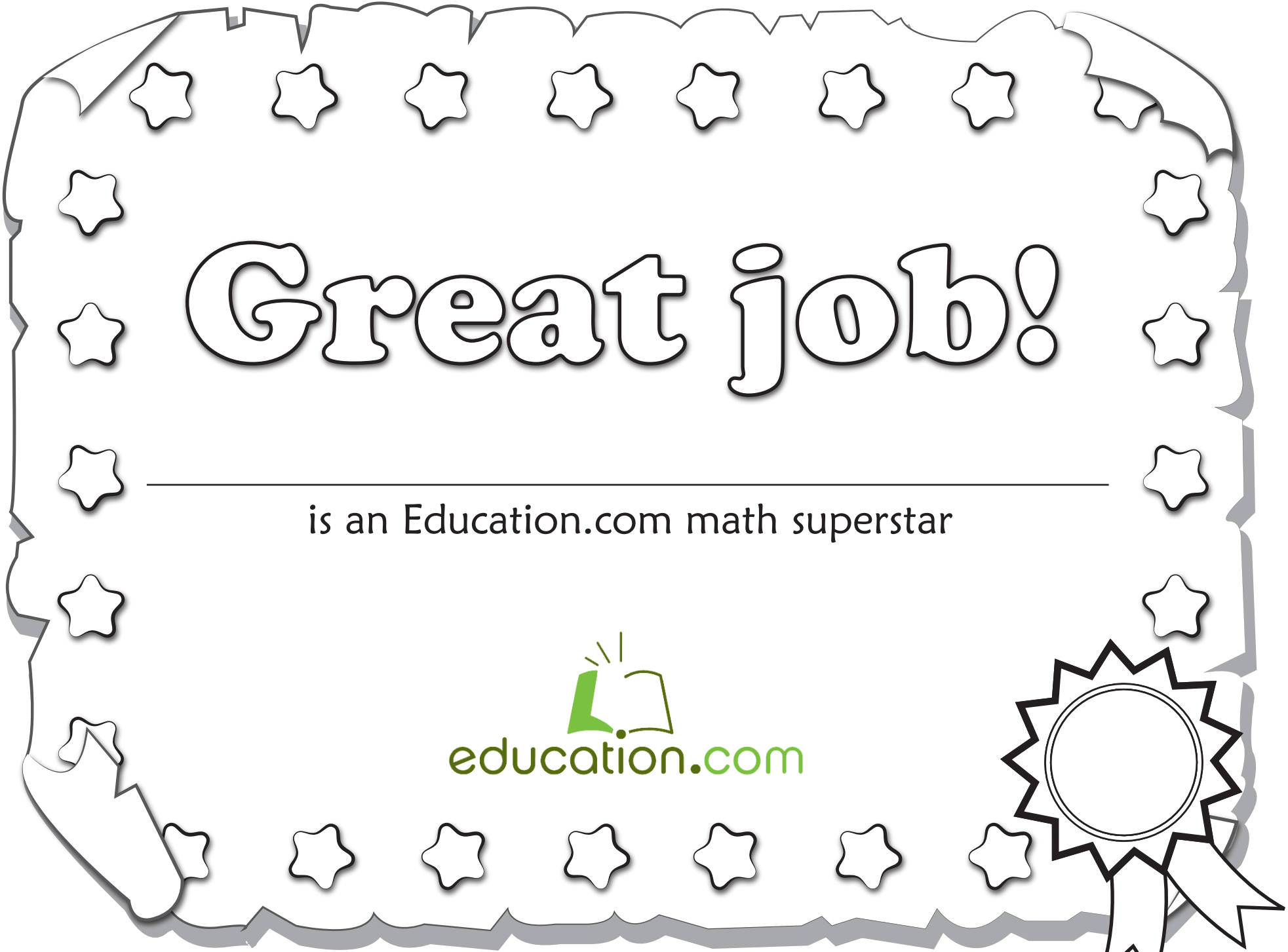
