•If you spot a VW Beetle or Bug, shout out "Slug Bug!" or "Punch Buggy!"


•Shout the color of the car.


•Gently punch your friend or family member in the arm.




Since old Beetles are rare now, a new Bug can count as 1 punch, and the old Beetle counts for 2 punches.

How many Slug Bugs did you see on your trip?





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
